This Christmas, may you find time to step away from the noise, embrace the light of Christ, and reflect that light to others. My prayer is that this season will be filled with His peace, joy, and hope for you and your loved ones.

# HOOPS FOR CHRIST YOUTH BASKETBALL LEAGUE

Here's a little bit of interesting info on our Hoops for Christ Youth Basketball ministry...

We have 66 players divided into eight teams with Biblical team names: Psalms, Disciples, Kings, Proverbs, Exodus,

Revelation, Judges, and Genesis. Four teams are K-2<sup>nd</sup> grade players and four teams are 3<sup>rd</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> grade.

Of the 66 players, 14 have played 3 or more years with us, 29 have played 1-2 years and 23 are brand new team members! Of the 66 players, 55 are NOT regular attenders or members of our church. That's the HUGE level of outreach that this program provides into our community! Of the 66 players, 22 have a Conover address. The other 44 come from Hickory, Newton, Catawba and even as far as Lincolnton and Statesville.

We have 2 or 3 coaches per team and several other youth and adults who help run this ministry every week. The coaches will be teaching basketball skills along with sharing prayers, scripture and devotionals every week. The kids have memory verses for each week of practice and play. Solid Biblical teaching is interwoven into every part of this program. It's NOT just about basketball!

We provide a play area for siblings and other children when they aren't on the court. We provide hospitality to the players through a snack with each game. We provide hospitality to the spectators with free coffee and concessions throughout all the games. (Still looking for volunteers to help provide this for the games after Christmas!)

And we provide encouragement and witness to the spectators by sharing a short (3-5 minute) devotional during half-time for each game. (4 games per Saturday). Would you be willing to do this one Saturday? Be the face and voice of Christ for our community?

Games will be on Saturdays: December 14 & 21; January 11, 18, and 25; and February 1.

Mark your calendars and plan to come cheer for these players at a few of their games! It's the best free fun you can find on a Saturday morning! Most of all, pray for this ministry... the coaches, players, families, and all who will be impacted.
