

Day 1: Love God with Your Mind

Devotional: Have you ever wondered why Jesus specifically mentioned the mind when describing how to love God? In a culture that often separates faith from intellect, Jesus calls us to engage our entire being in loving our Creator. Day 2: Growing in Wisdom

Bible Verse: 'And Jesus grew in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and man.' Luke 2:52

Reflection Question: What area of learning is God calling you to pursue, and how might this help you serve others?

Quote: We are students of God, growing in our capacity to love Him with our minds.

Prayer: Father, help me embrace learning as a lifelong journey. Give me humility to grow and wisdom to use what I learn for Your glory. Amen.

Day 3: All Truth Belongs to God

Devotional: Science and faith are not enemies. Every truth discovered in creation reflects the brilliance of the Creator. Learning strengthens faith when we see God's design at work.

Bible Verse: 'We take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.' 2 Corinthians 10:5

Reflection Question: How has learning about the world strengthened your faith?

Quote: Faith and science belong together because all truth is God's truth.

Prayer: God, help me see Your fingerprints in everything I learn. Give me wisdom as I pursue truth. Amen.

Day 4: Guarding Against Pride

Bible Verse: Romans 1:21
