WEEK THREE - RECOMMITTING TO THE COVENANT

WELCOME EVERYONE & READ THE SCRIPTURE (7 MINUTES)

Today we are going to talk about recommiting to our marriage covenant. We'll do a self-assessment of 1 Corinthians 13, discuss areas of improvement, and then have a time of recommittment. Open in prayer asking that everyone would have a posture of humility and grace.

Love is **patient**, love is **kind**, It does **not envy**, it does **not boast**, it is **not proud**. 5 It does **not dishonor** others, it is **not self-seeking**, it is **not easily angered**, it keeps **no record of wrongs**.

6 Love does **not delight in evil** but rejoices with the truth. 7 It **always protects**, **always trusts**, **always hopes**, **always perseveres**. 1 CORINTHIANS 13:4-7 (NIV)

One could say that these characteristics are necessary for love to go the distance. Give everyone some space to assess themselves against these characteristics, then discuss the questions with their spouse.

1 CORINTHIANS 13 SELF-ASSESSMENT (15 MINUTES)
Go through and rate yourself on the following questions.

- Needs a Lot of Work -Neutral Considered a Strengtha Mastered It PATIENCE: How patient are you with other people? KINDNESS: How considerate are you of others? NOT FNVIOUS: How easy is it to celebrate others' successes? How easy is it to not tell a "one-up" story? NOT BOASTFUL OR PROUD: How would those at work rate your humility? NOT EASILY ANGERED: How much control do you have of your anger? KEEPS NO RECORD OF WRONGS: How easy is it to let go of past hurts or wrongs?



DISCUSS WITH YOUR SPOUSE

Share with your spouse your weakest area.

Ask your spouse if they think this weak area has brought tension in the marriage.



DEBRIEF THE SELF-ASSESSMENT (1 MINUTE)

Be careful not to be overly critical about yourself. Don't be discouraged just to see this an an opportunity to grow, and an invitation for God to do a deep work in your life.

RE-LOOK AT THE WEDDING VOWS (8 MINUTES)

Exchange the following vows with your spouse in front of everyone. Ask everyone to listen closely and remember their own vows.

I, (husband), take you, (wife), to be my wife...to have and to hold...from this day forward... in prosperity or adversity...in sickness and in health...to love and to cherish...and I give myself to you... all that I am...and all that I possess... until death parts us...and to this covenant...I pledge you my faithfulness.

I, (wife), take you (husband), to be my husband...to have and to hold...from this day forward... in prosperity or adversity...in sickness and in health...to love and to cherish...and I give myself to you... all that I am...and all that I possess... until death parts us ...and to this covenant...I pledge you my faithfulness.

HAVE YOU LIVED UP TO YOUR PROMISE?

These vows call us to a sacrificial type of love toward your spouse.

Let's have a moment of honesty with a few questions regarding the vows we made when we married. Make sure you give plenty of grace and mercy in this moment.



DISCUSS WITH YOUR SPOUSE (8 MINUTES)

In what ways do you feel that you haven't lived up to your vows. Share them with your spouse. Maybe an apology would be appropriate.

After hearing your spouse, reaffirm them and accept the apology.

TIME OF RECOMMITMENT? (2 MINUTES)

We are really opening ourselves up and being vulnerable. Let's take a moment and speak some new vows to our spouse. Guys, you'll go first and then it will be the lady's turn.

After you say your vows, have them pray for their spouse. They've been given three things to pray about.

HUSBAND:

I promise to be patient with you, to listen when you need me to. To wait when you're figuring things out, and to choose kindness even when life gets messy.

I won't envy what others have because you're my gift, my partner. I won't boast or let pride get in the way of us.

I choose to honor you, protect your heart, and keep no record of wrongs - because love doesn't do that. I'll trust you, hope with you, and persevere through every season, because this love we're building is not just for now - it's forever. With God's help, I'll love you like that, every single day.

Pray: Thank God for your wife. Pray for God's help to live up to this commitment. Pray that God mends your hearts together.

WIFE:

I promise to be patient with you, even when we're running late or life throws us a curveball. I'll choose kindness, showing up with a gentle word or a smile when you need it most.

I won't let jealousy or pride sneak into our marriage - I'm all in for you. I'll forgive quickly, trust deeply, and hold onto hope no matter what comes our way.

I promise to love you with a love that endures, that protects, that never gives up. With God as our foundation, I'm yours, fully, forever.

Pray: Thank God for your husband. Pray for God's help to live up to this commitment. Pray that God mends your hearts together.
