## *The Kehoe Family*



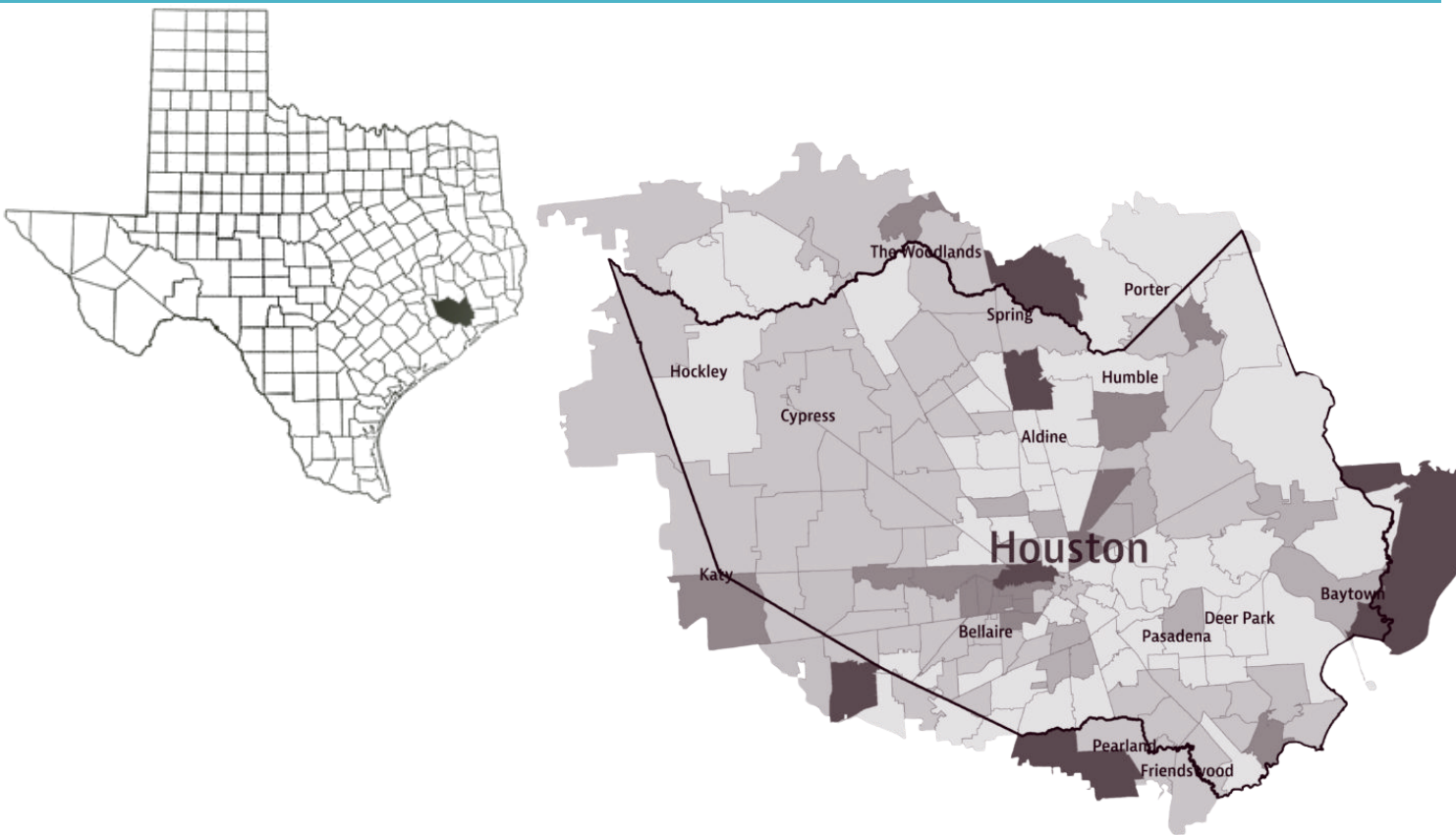

Greater Houston is the most ethnically diverse metropolitan area in the United States. At least 145 languages are spoken by city residents, and 90 nations have consular representation in the city.

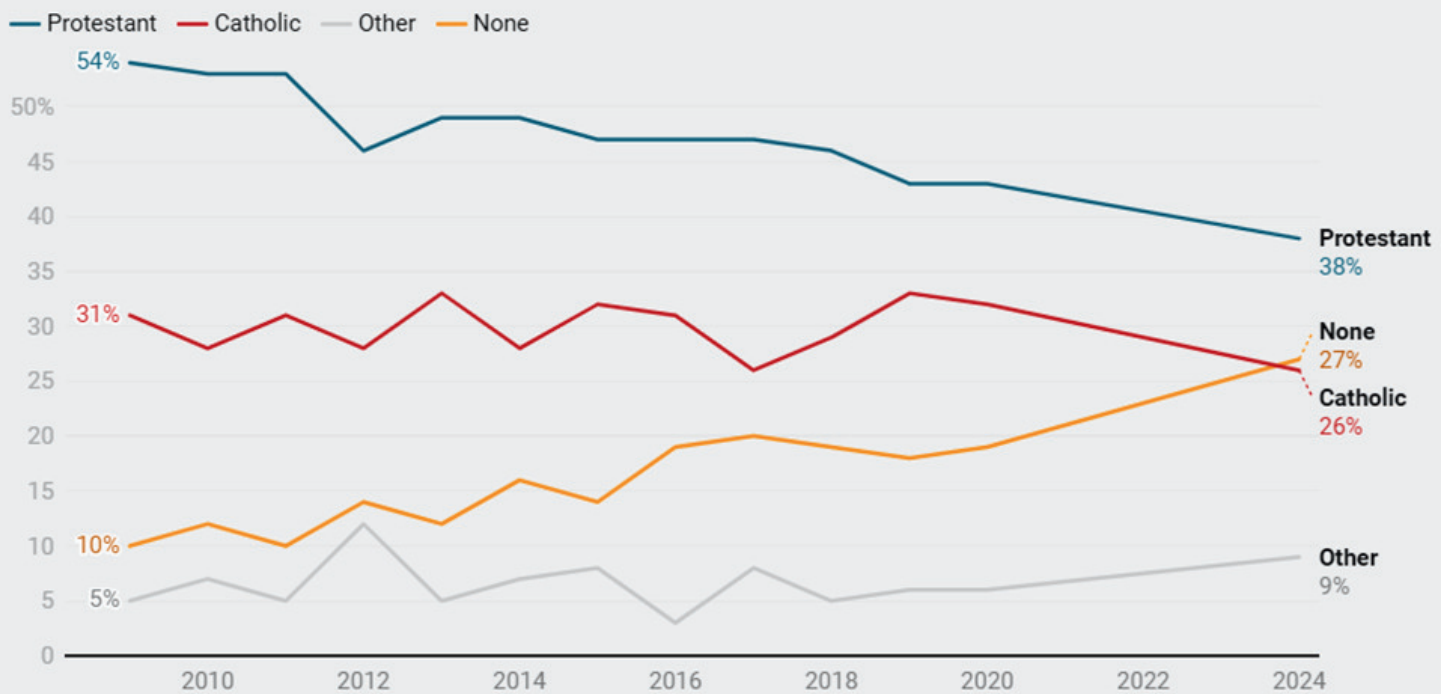
The Greater Houston area is larger than New Jersey and continues to expand. We will be planting in the Northwest Town of Hockley. One of the fastest growing areas of Houston.

**The percentage of religiously unaffiliated Houston-area residents has steadily risen in the past 15 years.**

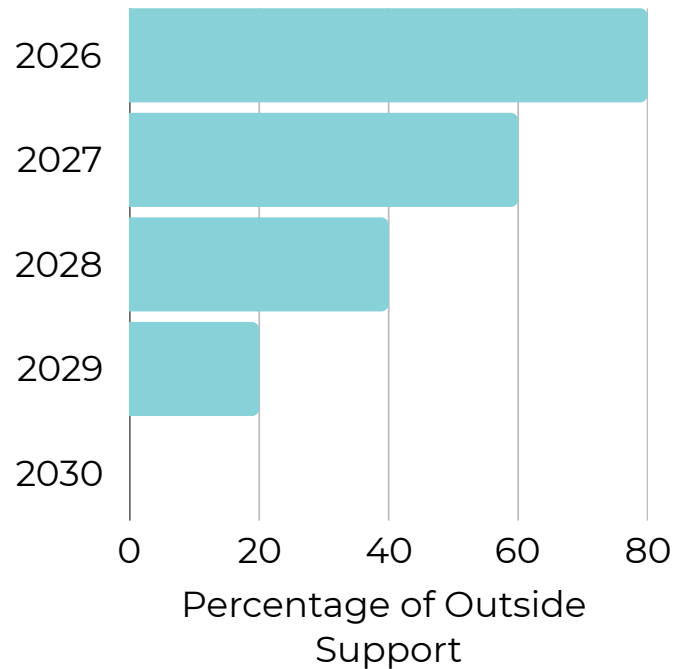
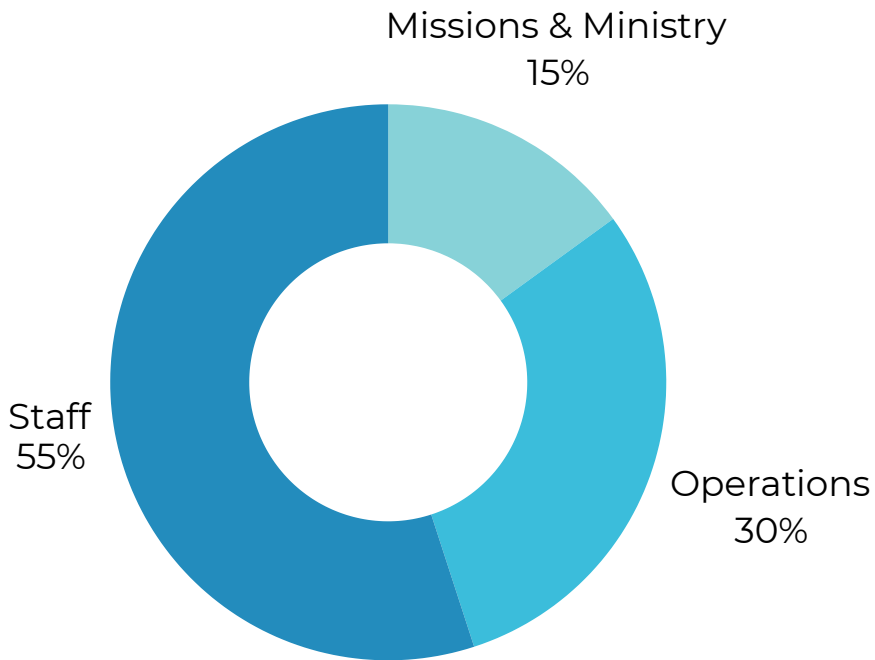

Individuals identifying with Christ are on the decline. This trend reflects the reality of lostness and the rapid increase of Houston's population. Also, this decline is due in part to the influx of international migration to Houston. Houston hosts over 220,000 residents from countries and people groups who have little to no access to the Gospel.

Gospel Hope will be a faithful light in the growing darkness through expositional preaching, relational evangelism, and community care.

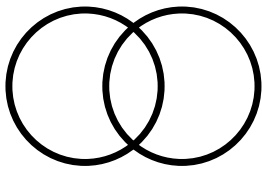
## **PRAY**

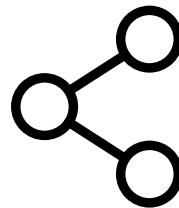
