Why We Need the Gospel: Because of God's Judgment on all People!

Rom. 3:1-20

For the past three weeks we have been following Paul's argument for why we need the gospel in our lives. He tells us that we need the gospel because his wrath, or his righteous, holy, unchanging anger toward sin, is on those who are immoral and reject God and on those who rely on their own morals to make it to heaven. Last week Paul sneaked up on the religious Jew and drove home the point that their heritage, or knowledge of the Bible, or their religious ceremonies were not sufficient to get them to heaven. Paul left us chest-deep in the judgment of God. But now Paul is about to bury us completely in the judgment of God as he drives the last nail in the proverbial coffin.
