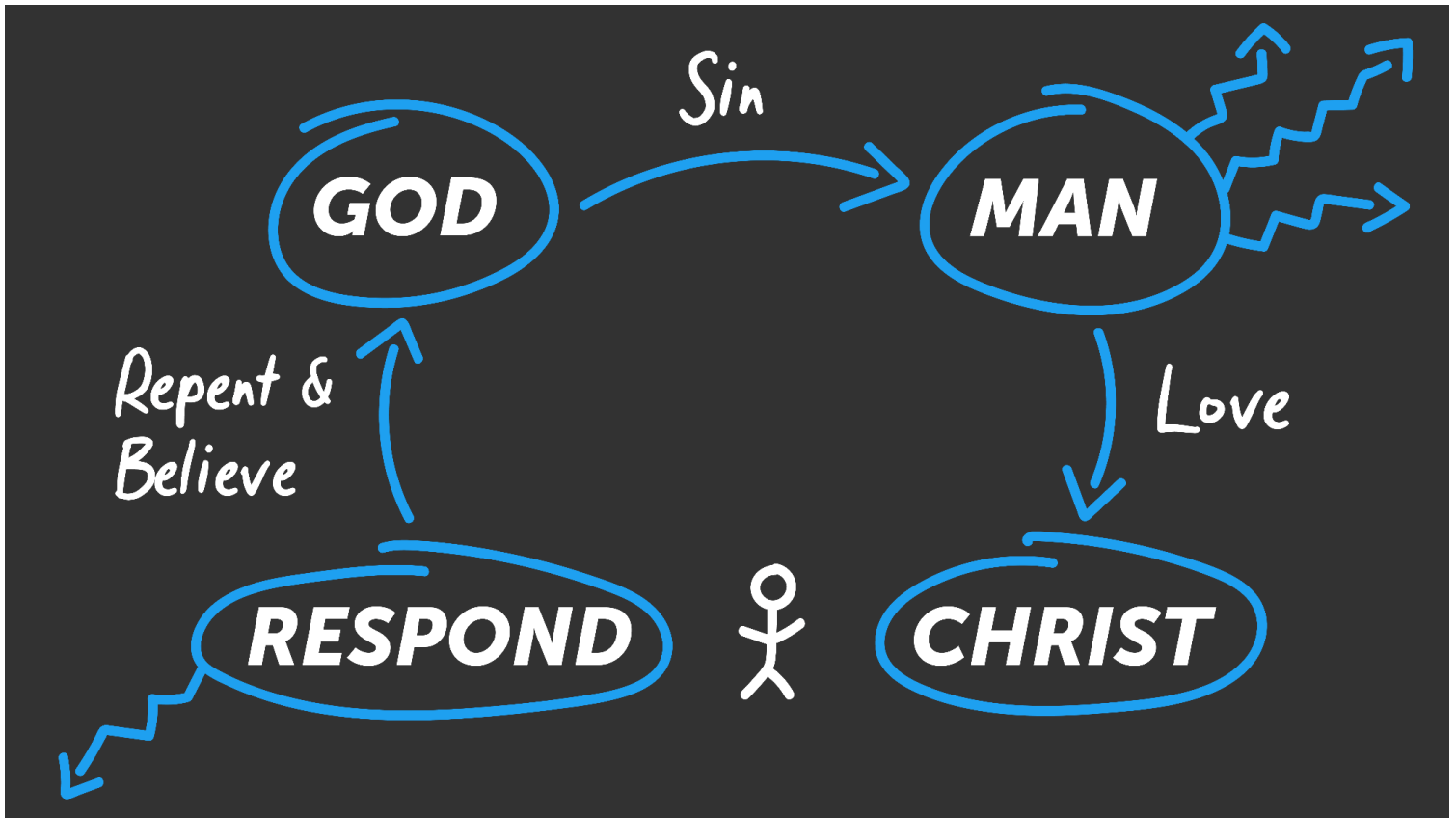


4 Circles



Gospel Circles: Full Script for Sharing the Gospel Visually

This script is designed for use with a simple visual tool. As you share the Gospel, you draw each part while speaking.

The key movements are: GOD → MAN → CHRIST → RESPOND

GOD

Write the word "GOD" — but do not circle it yet.

SAY: "Let's begin with God. The Bible says, 'In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth' (Genesis 1:1). God is the Creator of everything, including us. That means He has authority over all creation.

But God isn't just powerful. He is also holy — set apart and pure. He is righteous — He always does what is good, just, and true. Psalm 7:11 says that God is a righteous judge."

Now that you've shared all the truths about God, circle "GOD." (This signals a completed thought. Pause, then ask a question:)

Ask:

- "Have you ever thought about God like this?"
- "Who do you think God is?"

Draw an arrow from GOD to MAN and label it: "SIN."

SAY : "Although we were created to live in perfect relationship with God, something broke that relationship — We sinned against God. Sin isn't just bad behavior; it's when we reject God's rule and try to be in charge of our own lives. Our sin broke that relationship and caused great separation between God and us."

MAN

Write the word "MAN" — but do not circle it yet.

SAY: "The Bible says, 'All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God' (Romans 3:23). Sin is rejecting God's authority and going our own way. Because God is holy and just, sin causes a break in our relationship with Him. Isaiah 59:2 says, 'Your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God.' That separation comes with eternal consequences. On our own, we are spiritually lost and dead in our sins with no hope and experiencing brokenness."

Draw squiggly arrows around MAN

SAY: "These show how people try all sorts of things to fix their brokenness: success, relationships, pleasure, even religion. But nothing we try can restore us to God."

Now circle "MAN." (This ends the thought. Pause and ask:)

Ask:

- "Do you ever feel this sense of brokenness?"
- "How do you usually cope with pain or emptiness?"
- "Do you think there might be something more?"

Draw an arrow from MAN to CHRIST and label it: "LOVE."

SAY: But Praise God didn't leave us in our sin. In His great love, He made a way back to Himself through Jesus."

CHRIST

Write the word "CHRIST" — but do not circle it yet.

SAY : "That way is not through our effort or goodness—it's through **Jesus Christ**, His Son. Jesus is the only one who could rescue us. He lived a perfect, sinless life. He willingly died on the cross in our place, taking the punishment we deserved.

John 3:16 says, 'For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.'

Jesus didn't stay dead. On the third day, He rose again, defeating sin and death. The resurrection proves that Jesus has victory and shows He is the only one who can restore our relationship with God."

Now circle "CHRIST." (This ends the thought. Pause and ask:)

Ask:

- "Who do you think Jesus is?"
- "Have you ever heard Jesus explained like this before?"
- "Do you believe you need a Savior?"

Draw a stick figure to represent the person you're talking to.

SAY: "This is where it comes to you. This is you. God has done everything needed to restore your relationship with Him—but you must respond.

RESPOND

Draw the word "RESPOND" — but do not circle it yet.

SAY : "Everything we've talked about leads to this moment. You have a choice. Will you continue to live separated from God, or will you turn from your sin and trust in Jesus?

Jesus said in Mark 1:15, 'Repent and believe the gospel.' That means to turn away from your sin and trust in Jesus alone to save you. We can choose to respond towards God, which leads to eternal life and rebuilds the relationship we were meant to have. Because of Christ, this is possible again to live with God and enjoy Him forever."

Draw an arrow from RESPOND to GOD and label it: "Repent and Believe"

SAY: "Or you can continue in your sin, the separation from God remains. You can continue to search for other wise to fix your lack of hope and brokenness but those will never last or rebuild that relationship with God we were created to have. This response leads to eternal separation from God in Hell that is an eternal place of judgement for sin.

Draw an arrow going away from God with a squiggly line (continued separation)

Now circle "RESPOND." (This ends the thought. Pause and ask:)

Ask:

- "How are you responding to this right now?"
- "What is keeping you from trusting Jesus today?"
- "Have you heard this message before?"

SAY: "This is the good news: Jesus is the only one who can set you free from your sin and bring you back into a right relationship with God. He invites you to trust in Him and turn from your sin today. Would you like to trust in Jesus today? I can help you talk to God and begin that relationship.
