Having, as we trust, been brought by Divine Grace to repent and believe in the Lord Jesus Christ, and dedicating ourselves to Him, and having been baptized in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit upon our confession of faith, we now joyfully and solemnly renew our covenant with one another, relying on God's gracious aid.

We commit to work and pray for the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

We commit, as members of a Christian Church, to walk together in brotherly love.

We will affectionately care for and watch over each other.

We will faithfully admonish and entreat one another as occasion requires.

We commit to gathering together regularly and to consistently pray for ourselves and others.

We are committed to working together to maintain a devoted evangelical ministry within this church, upholding its worship, ordinances, discipline, and doctrines.

We will seek to raise those in our care in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

We will seek the salvation of our family and friends through sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ.

We will celebrate each other's joys and, with tenderness and empathy, seek to share each other's burdens and sorrows.

We commit, with God's help, to live thoughtfully in the world, denying ungodliness and worldly desires. Having been voluntarily buried and resurrected again from the symbolic grave through baptism, we are especially called to lead new and holy lives.

We commit to cheerfully and consistently contribute to the support of ministry, church expenses, and the global spread of the Gospel.

If we move from this place, we commit to unite with a church, as soon as possible, where we can uphold the spirit of this covenant and the principles of God's Word.

May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with us all. Amen.
