1. Life Before Christ

Set the stage: Tell the Story of what your life was like before Christ. Include these Gospel truths:

- God is Creator & Holy: Describe your understanding or misunderstanding of God. Did you know God's authority and holiness?
- Man's Sin & Separation: Share about how you lived apart from God. Did you realize sin separated you from Him? What was the condition of your heart or life?

Prompts to consider answering in your story:

2. How Jesus Met Me

3. Life After Accepting Christ

Describe the story of how your life changed after trusting Jesus. Include these Gospel truths:

- God's Forgiveness & Restoration: Talk about the forgiveness you experienced and how your relationship with God changed.
- Victory Over Sin: Share how Jesus' resurrection means He has power over sin in your life.

Prompts to consider answering in your story:

- What changed in your heart, mind, or daily life after accepting Christ?

4. The Response Everyone Must Make

Encourage others to consider their own response to Jesus.
