Band Team

Leads the church in worship through music by playing instruments or singing. Volunteers help create an engaging, Christ-centered worship environment where we exalt God, edify one another, and evangelize the lost.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Arrive on time for rehearsals and soundcheck
2. Learn music in advance using provided resources
3. Participate in team prayer and spiritual preparation
4. Follow the worship leader's direction during services
5. Maintain a worshipful, humble stage presence

Production Team

Supports worship and teaching through audio, lighting, and video systems to ensure smooth and excellent services.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Run sound, lighting, or presentation software
2. Assist with stage setup and tech preparation
3. Follow cues and service flow with precision
4. Troubleshoot basic tech issues with team guidance
5. Maintain a calm and focused environment

Load-In Team

Transforms portable spaces into ready ministry environments each week.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Unload the trailer
2. Set up signage, pipe and drape, chairs, and ministry rooms
3. Prepare Kids spaces with curriculum bins and supplies
4. Assist production and band with gear placement
5. Ensure all environments are clean, organized, and welcoming

Load-Out Team

Resets and packs up all ministry environments after services.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Tear down Kids spaces, signage, chairs, and pipe and drape
2. Pack and load equipment into storage or trailers
3. Assist production and band with gear strike
4. Ensure rooms are clean and returned to school standards
5. Work efficiently with a team mindset

Connections Team

Creates a warm, friendly, and helpful experience for guests and members from the moment they drive up.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Greet people with enthusiasm and genuine hospitality
2. Assist new families with check-in or directions
3. Help guests find seats during service
4. Answer basic questions or walk people to their destination
5. Follow up with first-time guests when assigned

Kids Team (Birth–3rd Grade)

Provides safe, fun, and biblically grounded environments for young children.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Welcome children and families at drop-off
2. Lead or support Bible lessons, crafts, and activities
3. Provide consistent care, supervision, and encouragement
4. Follow all safety, check-in, and security policies
5. Communicate clearly with parents at pick-up

Parking Team

Creates a positive first impression by ensuring safe and efficient parking flow.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Direct traffic and guide vehicles safely
2. Greet attendees as they arrive on campus
3. Assist families or elderly individuals when needed
4. Help maintain a smooth entry/exit flow
5. Serve as friendly “first touch” for guests

Safety Response Team (SRT)

Provides a safe and secure environment.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Monitor campus and ministry areas during services
2. Respond to medical needs with appropriate training
3. Support evacuation or emergency procedures if necessary
4. Partner with Kids and Connections teams for a safe and welcoming atmosphere
5. Maintain a welcoming presence and professionalism at all times

Communications Team

Captures and shares the ministry story through photography, video, and digital content.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Take photos or video clips during services and events
2. Edit and upload content as needed
3. Assist with social media posts and storytelling
4. Follow church branding and media guidelines
5. Coordinate with Communications Staff for coverage needs
