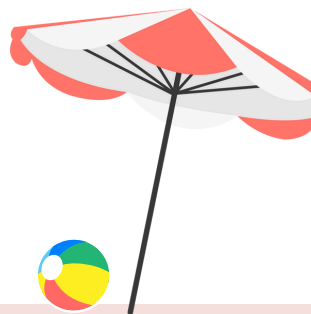

- Winter/Spring: January 7 – April 29

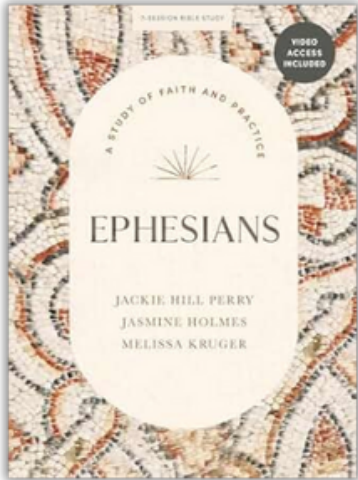


Time: Wednesdays from 6:30–8:00 PM
