HELPFUL NOTES FOR PARENTS

Infants are welcome in the sanctuary during the worship service to participate as they are able. We also have a Parents' Room (Parlor-A4) located just off of the sanctuary where you can watch and hear the service in a comfortable, private setting. Infant and toddler care is also offered by trained volunteers in the Nursery (room C11).

Jesus did not come merely to forgive sins—he came to confront, disarm, and defeat the powers of darkness. He came to reverse the three cosmic rebellions! In the sixth message of our series, Pastor David explores how Jesus affirmed the cosmic spiritual warfare worldview through his temptations, exorcisms, teachings, transfiguration, death, and resurrection, and he explains how Jesus disarmed the powers and established his authority over everything in heaven and on earth.

PRINCIPALITIES & POWERS *current sermon series*

The Apostle Paul wrote, “For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms” (Ephesians 6:12). The Bible tells a story of a real cosmic conflict—where spiritual rebellion has corrupted the world—but through Jesus, God is reclaiming the nations, and he invites his people to participate in this spiritual fight through prayer. *Principalities & Powers: Our Spiritual Fight Against the Forces of Darkness* is an 8-week sermon series exploring the unseen spiritual conflict behind human history, the victory of Christ over evil, and the role of believers in spiritual warfare through prayer. Join us each week (May 3-June 21) as we learn about our real enemy and how to fight like Jesus.
