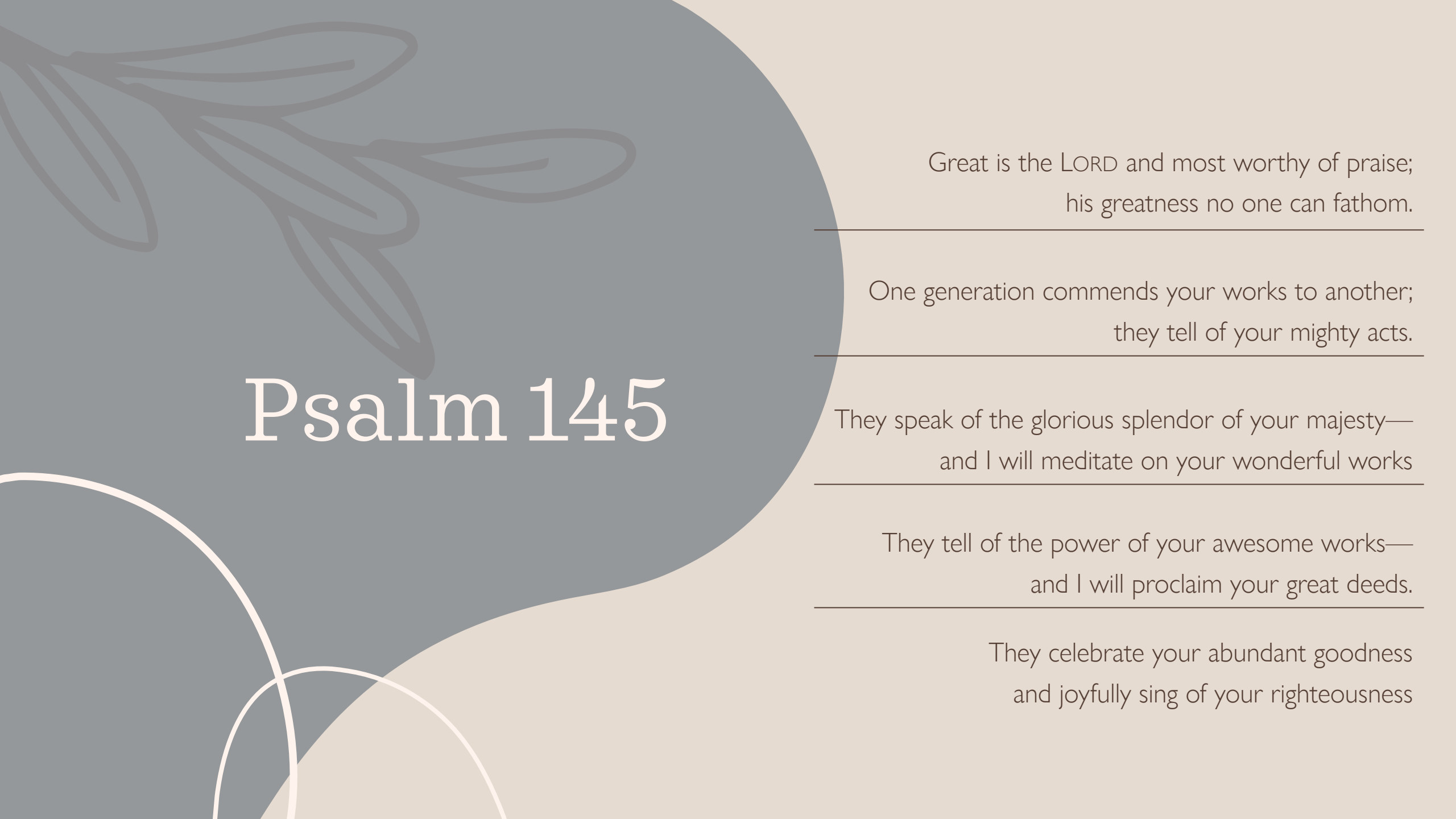

and I will meditate on your wonderful works

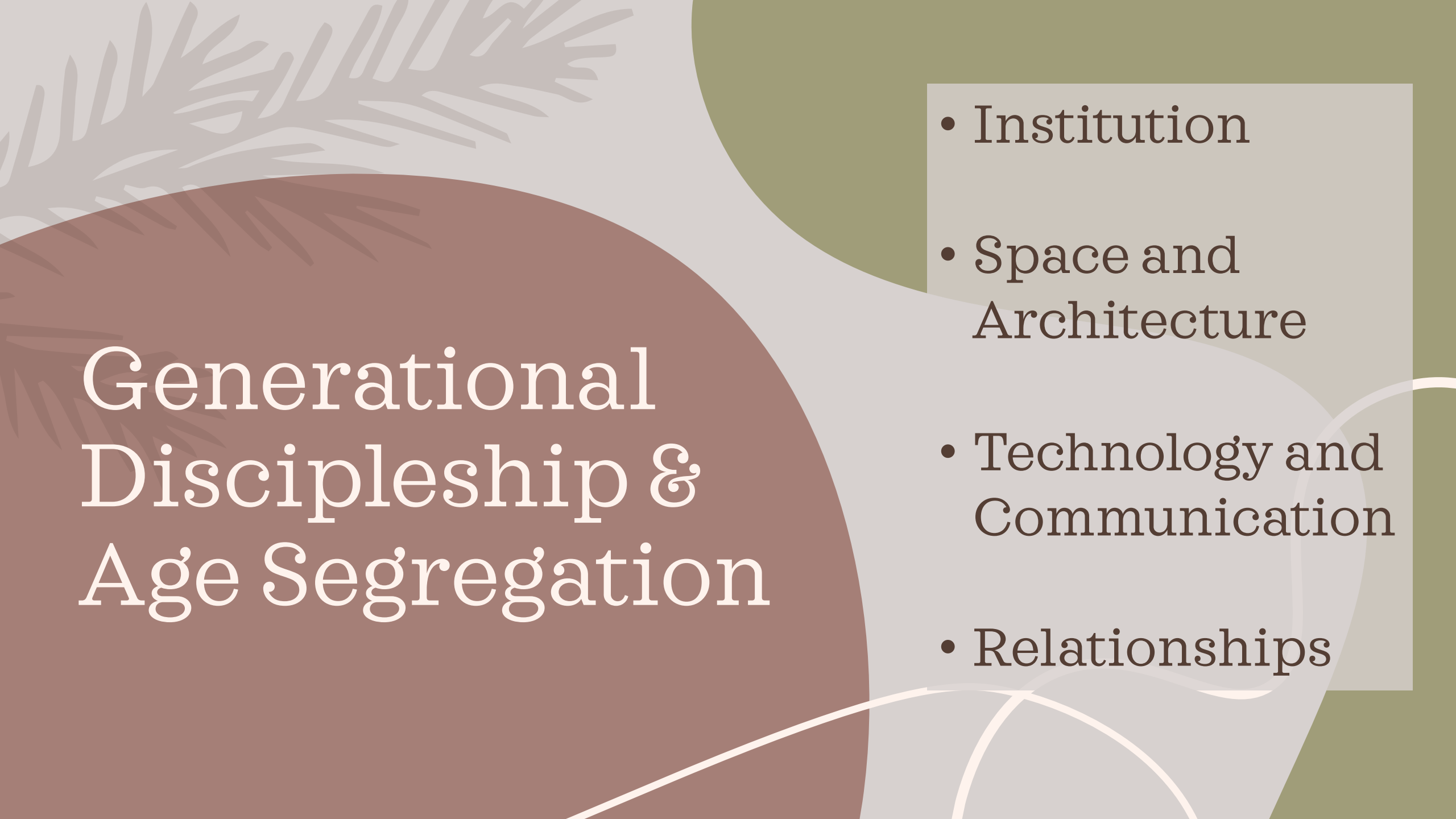
They tell of the power of your awesome works—

LOVING GOD (WORSHIP)

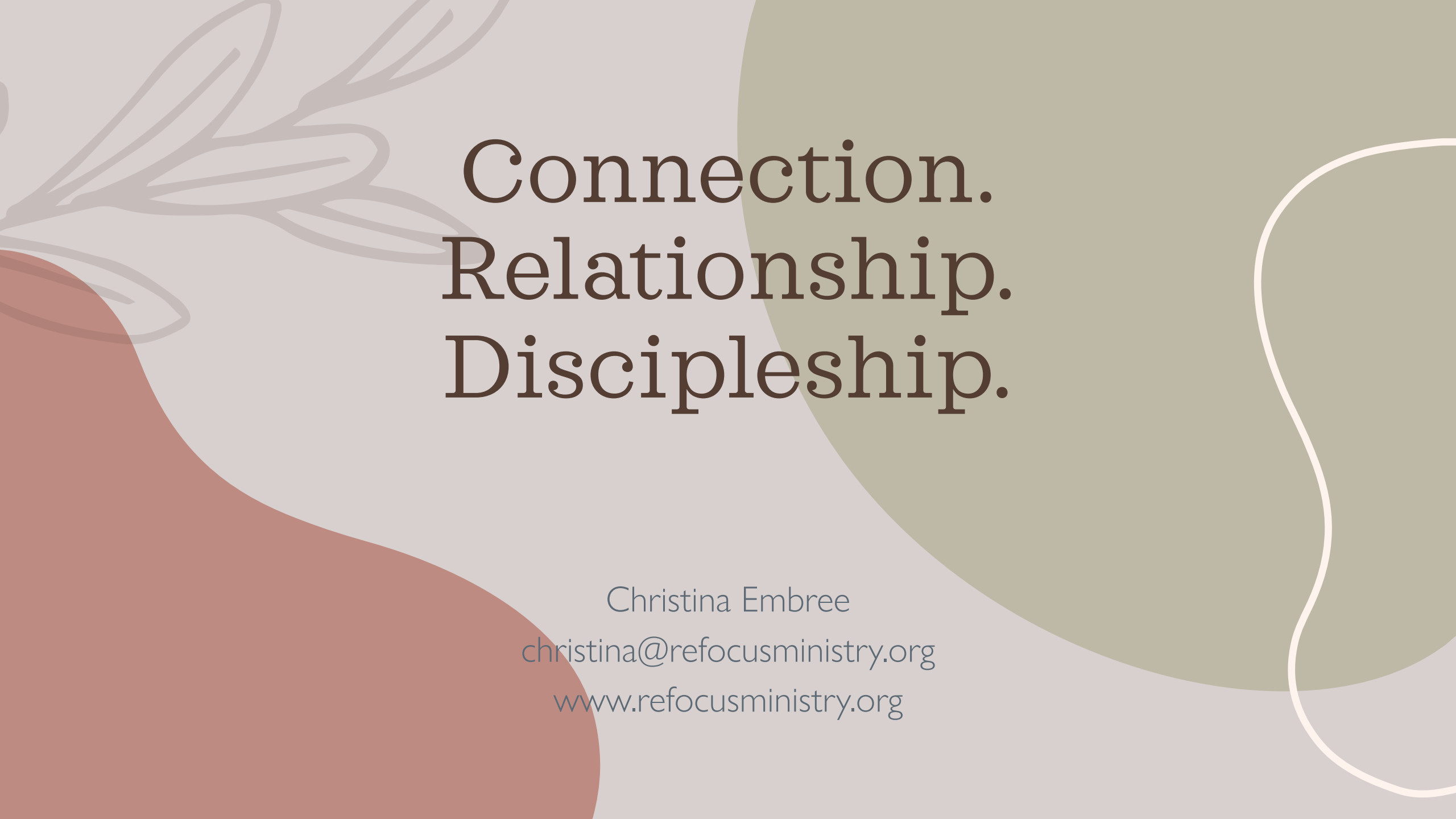
