DISCIPLES ARE...



Disciples are people in community who – empowered by the Holy Spirit – are growing to love, follow, and lead others to the God who looks like Jesus.

NOTE: We do discipleship together in *community*, we depend on the Holy Spirit to help us *progress*, and the results should be *observable*—loving, following and leading others to God.

- Is it enough to count the number of people who attend Learning Community on Sunday morning?




