Sermon Title: The Gift of Grace

Scripture Reading: Ephesians 2:8-9

Sermon Focus: Grace is a gift from God that cannot be earned or purchased. It is the good news that lies at the very heart of the gospel that we proclaim. Even greater is to know that grace is not just for ourselves. The grace of God doesn't give us freedom to live for ourselves. In *The Gift of Grace*, Todd Allen reminds us how the grace of God gives us freedom to live for someone and something much greater than ourselves—that someone called Jesus and that something called the Kingdom of God.

Thank you for going deeper in conversation with your small group in person or by video call. Use the following questions to help *guide* your small group discussion:

1. Read Ephesians 2:8-9. What are ways we tend to try and earn God's grace?
2. Why is it sometimes difficult to believe that God loves us no matter what we do or don't do? Is there an area in your life today where you are struggling to receive God's grace?
3. What is your testimony of grace? As you look back over your life, where can you see the hand of God at work, even in times you weren't aware or didn't care?
4. Where do you see evidence that grace is (as Dr. Allen said) "the one thing the world can't duplicate, but the one thing they crave above all else"?
5. Dr. Allen reminded us that, being saved by grace, we are also called to be agents of grace. Where is God be calling you to extend grace to someone in your life right now? What might that look like?
