Confronting Bounded Thinking

ACTS 11:1-18, 15:1-5
GALATIANS 2:1-21
EPHESIANS 2:8-9

Paul said that the leaders of the Jerusalem church had accepted him and his ministry, so why are the Galatians now listening to a false gospel from some law-abiding agitators? Paul even says that he confronted Peter in Antioch after he accepted and ate with Gentiles but then changed his mind when the agitators arrived. In the second message of our series, Pastor David shares why this is a big problem and how we must lovingly confront *bounded* thinking with the gospel of God's grace.

The Apostle Paul wrote a passionate letter to the churches in Galatia that has the potential to lead us to more profoundly experience the liberating work of Jesus in and through Christian community. Paul wrote, "My children—I seem to be in labor with you all over again, until the Messiah is fully formed in you!"
