Non-Retaliation and Enemy Love

EXODUS 21:23-25 LEVITICUS 19:18 DEUTERONOMY 7:1-4 MATTHEW 5:38-48

In Matthew 5:38-48, Jesus reveals his deeper wisdom from the Torah as it relates to retaliation, justice, and nonviolent resistance to injustice. Jesus gives us several examples of what this looks like and then tells us that the true children of God are those who love their enemies and pray for those who oppress and persecute them. In the ninth message of our series, Pastor David helps us understand what Jesus means and then he invites us to accept the call to creative non-violence and enemy love.

The Sermon on the Mount, Part 1 current series

Matthew 5-7 is known as the Sermon on the Mount. Jesus went up a mountain and a large crowd gathered to hear him preach a powerful message—proclaiming the gospel of the Kingdom and casting a vision of what it looks like to live in right relationship with God, our neighbors, and our enemies. These three chapters contain the core of Jesus' teachings and his most well-known sayings, including some of the most rigorous ethical demands in the Bible.
