### No Other Gospel

**GALATIANS 1:1-24**

**ACTS 9:1-19**

**EPHESIANS 2:8-9**

Paul is upset, and it shows! What has provoked his passionate letter to the churches in Galatia? Paul planted the churches in that region. And not long after, his work and the fragile faith of these Gentile Christians are being threatened by a "good news" that is different than the one he gave them. In the first message of our series, Pastor David shares historical context, guides us through chapter 1, and invites us to embrace God's gospel of grace that makes centered-set community possible.

#### Galatians *current sermon series*

The Apostle Paul wrote a passionate letter to the churches in Galatia that has the potential to lead us to more profoundly experience the liberating work of Jesus in and through Christian community. Paul wrote, "My children—I seem to be in labor with you all over again, until the Messiah is fully formed in you!" Join us for Lent 2025 as we explore this letter to better understand the problem that provoked Paul to write it, and as we seek to gain new insights by using the concept of bounded, fuzzy, and centered-set churches as a lens for interpreting and applying Galatians to our lives.
