following Aug 31 from whenever you start and serve 2 services a month.

Purpose of Position:

2 Corinthians 5:20 states we are to be ambassadors for Christ. This position represents Christ by making known the redeeming, renewing, and reconciling love of Jesus by caring for 2- to 5-year-olds, teachers, assistants & helpers, children's parents, and the entire church. This roll is responsible to oversee all that happens in the pre-k rooms during a service from check-in to pick up. This includes making sure the space is safe for everyone, ensuring everyone has a positive experience, a chance to interact with Jesus, and that any issue gets resolved or passed onto a staff member to follow up with. As a Lead you will be responsible for others serving in the pre-k area and dealing with any issues, while determining what to pass on to staff to deal with. You create a space for parents to engage with God without the distraction of an active pre-k child distracting them, answer parent questions, and make sure parents and their children feel secure about joining the pre-k rooms during service. Lastly, you help create a space where the church body can worship and hear from God.

Responsibilities & Expectations:

- Show up on time, prepared, to love and lead other team members, children, and their parents.
- Communicate with the scheduler in a timely manner. Commit to responding to Planning Center.
- Read, know, follow, and enforce SVA's policy and procedures to keep kids, yourself, and SVA safe.
- Make sure the rooms are set up and cleaned up properly.
- Help oversee all aspects of day from set up, through check-in, to service flow, pick up, and clean up.
- Follow the staffs direction and requests while communicating any feedback or incidents that occur so they can follow up with parents.
- Help children experience the joy and love of God, while learning that He is trustworthy and good.
- Be able and willing to help where needed, but comfortable delegating to other team members.
- Attendance at bi-annual trainings or celebrations.

- Have a relationship with Jesus.
