It's important that this role engages both children and parents, is comfortable with technology, and can be consistent in serving regularly. This is an important part of a family's experience.

Responsibilities & Expectations

- Show up on time to set up and prepare check in area, staying until 15 minutes into service or all families are checked in.
- Communicate with the scheduler in a timely manner. Commit to responding to Planning Center invitations.
- Read, know, follow, and enforce SVA's policy and procedures to keep kids, yourself, and SVA safe.
- Joyfully great families and children while ensuring check in is as efficiently as possible.
- Understand and know how SVA Sunday's run and who/where to send people if they have questions.
- Welcome new families and make sure they get settled.
- Attendance at bi-annual trainings or celebrations.
