



Volunteer Position: *Journey Kids Nursery Team Assistant/Helper*

Time Commitment: *27 services a year (Sept. 1-Aug 31) We ask you commit to is serving through the following Aug 31 from whenever you start and serve 1-2 services a month. This can be modified to fit your schedule if you're only 1 service a month.*

Purpose of Position:

2 Corinthians 5:20 states we are to be ambassadors for Christ. This position represents Christ by making known the redeeming, renewing, and reconciling love of Jesus by caring for infants to 2 years old, their parents, and the entire church. Directly, you get to create a safe, fun, and caring environment for children's first experience of God. That might be done through holding an infant, engaging with a 2 year old playing with farm animals, or comforting a child who's experiencing being out of their parents presence for the first time. You create a space for parents to engage with God without the distraction of having to care for their infants, and you help create a space where the church body can worship and hear from God.

Responsibilities & Expectations:

- *Show up on time, prepared to love and care for infants-2-year old's.*
- *Communicate with the scheduler in a timely manner. Commit to responding to Planning Center invitations.*
- *Read, know, and follow SVA's policy and procedures to keep kids, yourself, and SVA safe.*
- *Love, care, connect, and engage with infants on their level, while demonstrating how God does those things with you.*
- *Follow the staff, and Nursery Lead's direction and requests.*
- *Help children experience joy, love, and a healthy place.*
- *Help prepare the room, clean up, and put away toys and the room as directed.*
- *Attendance at bi-annual trainings or celebrations.*

Special Qualifications for this Position:

- *Preferred that you have a relationship with Jesus.*
- *Completed application and Background Check are required.*
