

Volunteer Position: Lingering Prayer Team

Time Commitment: 6 months – 1 year

Purpose of Position:

At SVA Church, we seek to encourage prayer in all areas of life: personal, for the church, and for our community. The lingering prayer team is a group of intercessors who are available at the end of each service to pray with and for others. Lingering prayer team members are available for Sunday services, prayer events and worship nights.

Responsibilities & Expectations:

- Whether or not someone calls the prayer team up, please move into place near the cross right as the final time of worship begins.
- As you wait, keep your eyes open and be ready for anyone who may want to come for prayer. If you are fully engaged in worship during this time, they may not feel comfortable approaching.
- Pray as you wait for God to move in your hearts and for who you may pray with during this time.
- As you wait, be praying for those that just heard the message. Pray that they would respond to how God is speaking and that each one would know the power of the resurrection.
- Those scheduled will linger for just a bit as people exit; some people may wait until that time. If no one comes up as the room empties, feel free to leave your spot.
- For those new to this team, you will be paired with a current team member before being scheduled on your own.
- Reports any concerns to overseeing pastor
- Is scheduled through planning center and will respond through pc for availability
- Attends a training meeting twice a year or as needed for special events

Special Qualifications for this Position:

- Has a personal, growing relationship with Jesus
- Has read and agrees with the SVA Statement of Faith
- Displays the spiritual gift of intercession, healing, shepherding or caring
- Must be able to maintain confidentiality
