# May 2024 Pastor's Letter

Grace and peace to you from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ; grace that provides divine assistance for daily living and peace to comfort us through all circumstances of life! The Apostle Paul started his letters to Christians with this blessing and encouragement because he wanted everyone who trusted Jesus as their Lord and Savior to receive and experience the fullness of the life God created them for.

Back in 2019, the Community Church Waterford celebrated its 150<sup>th</sup> year of ministry! It all started in 1870 when a powerful Awakening (a movement of God that went beyond the church and into the community) came to Waterford, and out of that amazing movement of God; 2 churches were born, the English Methodist Episcopal Church and the German Methodist Episcopal Church. One for English speaking believers and the other for German speaking believers. Believe it or not, in the 1870s, many of Waterford's citizens were German immigrants and they primarily spoke German. By 1928, very few residents of Waterford still spoke German, so the 2 churches merged to create the Community Methodist Episcopal Church. In 1968, the United Evangelical Brethren Church and the Methodist Episcopal Church merged to create the United Methodist Church, and in 2023 the Community Church Waterford moved to the Global Methodist Church.


One could ask, what was the significance of a Methodist Church being started in Waterford? The answer comes by understanding how the Methodist Episcopal Church was born out of what was called the "First Great Awakening" when Methodism emerged as an evangelical revival movement within the Church of England in 1784. And ever since, the Methodist Church had been involved in the next 7 Great Awakenings and Revivals that occurred in Modern Western History. And in Waterford, believers wanted to continue to experience the transformational grace of God. Experiencing the Spirit of God in supernatural ways and seeing lives transformed has long been a part of the history and ministry of the Community Church in Waterford.

One movement of God happened in the Methodist Episcopal Church in the late 19th century. Out of the 1885 Awakening, a dynamic group of young adults founded a ministry called the Epworth League in 1889 with the focus of helping young Christians grow as Disciples of Jesus Christ. The Epworth League nurtured spiritual growth through prayer, Bible study, and devotional practices. With an emphasis on the integration of faith into all aspects of life. This included praying for, building relationships with and loving neighbors through tangible acts of service! Then as these young Methodist Christians showed their love through God given opportunities, they were able to share their faith, and within 10 years, this movement grew to over 1.74 million members.

Throughout its history, the United States has experienced a Great Awakening about every 80 years (Roughly 1735, 1805, 1885, and 1965) with regional Awakenings and Revivals happening. They tended to last about 20 years before society started to unravel again. If this pattern continues in the US, another Great Awakening should come to North America around 2045. The Community Church has a long history of being actively involved in these movements of Holy Spirit. After the 1965 Great Awakening, God brought Rev. Peter Garcia to the Community Church in 1970; and then in 1984, God brought Rev. Clarence Cheever. These men of God created the foundation for the Body of Christ that we now experience.

Our amazing Triune God of Grace is moving once more! At the April Church Council, the Community Church Leadership unanimously agreed to support a new movement that is starting among us! This new movement is building upon our long history and passion of praying for our neighbors and community, following the direction of Holy Spirit and in each person's giftedness, connecting with neighbors and building relationships with them. Drawing from the teachings of Jesus, as the Methodists before us, we will encourage each other to ask our neighbors one simple question: "What can I do for you?" This question will become a catalyst for meaningful conversations, opportunities to meet the needs of others, and allow God to move in amazing ways. Then by investing in relationships with neighbors, we can create a ripple effect that will impact our neighborhoods and community that will lead to transformative change.

In upcoming months, we will share more of this vision that will allow God to create a stronger, more connected community by prioritizing relationships with those who live near us. My prayer is that the Lord will start to empower us to rethink the way we see and interact with our neighbors, and just as God used the Epworth League, allow Holy Spirit to move through us to build a better world right outside our own doors.



This series, Crazy For Lovin' You, will help us understand how we can use these tools and weapons in the relationships that drive us crazy. Whether it's a spouse, a significant other, sibling, parent, co-worker, relative, or that one person who loves causing crazy in your life. This series will help bring sanity and transformation into your relationships, so you not only survive - but thrive.






