#### **Pastor's Letter**

Grace and peace to you from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ; grace that provides divine assistance for daily living, and peace to comfort us through all circumstances of life through the power of the Holy Spirit! For the past few months, we have been talking about how we can take God's amazing grace outside our church and into our community. But that leads to 3 important questions, "What is the most affective way to introduce people to Jesus Christ in today's culture? How can we present ourselves naturally, more as a fellow pilgrim rather than an expert? How can we be believers whose loving actions speak louder than words?

You can find the answers in the last 3 Pastor Letters where I started introducing the Lighthouse Movement. In those letters there is a critical component called, "Prayer, Care and Share." That is the answer to the question, "How can we be more affective, natural, and loving as we introduce people to Jesus Christ?"

The Lighthouse Movement is a prayer movement around the world with the calling to pray for, and care for our neighbors while looking for opportunities to share our hope in Jesus Christ. This is equipping people to get out of the church and into their neighborhoods, schools, and offices to participate in an amazing movement of God where people are experiencing an awakening to Jesus Christ. Jesus said: "I am the light of the world. If you follow me, you will not stumble through the darkness because you will have the light that leads to life (John 8:12)." Remember, you are called to reflect the light of Jesus Christ and be a Lighthouse.

Next Lent, we will have a sermon series and an all-church study where we will learn:

How to bring God's amazing grace outside our church walls and become a lighthouse.

How to present ourselves as a fellow pilgrim and how to use prayer as the key resource.

How to be a believer whose acts of caring speak louder than words in ways that match their personality.

How to be more creative in the ways we share our faith, allowing Holy Spirit to inspire others to trust in Jesus Christ.

The lighthouse challenge is to choose three to five people in your family, neighborhood, school or workplace. Then:


**Prayer:** Pray for them regularly by name and ask God to use you as an influence.

Care: Watch for God given opportunities to demonstrate God's love with simple acts of caring. Do what you are good at and comfortable with, use your natural abilities to serve or gift those you are praying for. Be simple like baking cookies or bread, or serve in actions like cutting their grass, rake leaves or shovel snow.

**Share:** Pray and watch for God to provide an opportunity to share your faith in an appropriate way.

Imagine if all of us took this challenge? Remember, "You are the light of the world – like a city on a mountain, glowing in the night for all to see. Don't hide your light under a basket! Instead, put it on a stand and let it shine for all." (Mat. 5:14) Prayer, Care, Share and as the Prophet Isaiah said, "Come, people of Israel, let us walk in the light of the Lord!" (Isaiah 2:5).

And May the Lord bless your Fall with a wonderful Thanksgiving. Thank the Lord for all you have been blessed with, and for the opportunities you are given to bless and serve others. You are the Body of Christ!
