Pastor's Letter

Grace and peace to you from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ; grace that provides divine assistance for daily living, and peace to comfort us through all circumstances of life through the power of the Holy Spirit!

Do you remember what Jesus said were two greatest Commandments in Matthew 22:35-40, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart, mind, soul, and strength? And love your neighbor as yourself." In Jesus' day, Judaism called that the **Shema**, it is a central declaration of the Jewish faith as found in Deuteronomy 6:4-5. The Shema is recited daily in Jewish prayers and emphasizes the importance of loving God with every aspect of one's being.

For the past 3 Pastor Letters, I have been presenting a simple and practical, but extraordinary way to live the biblical Shema. It is a prayer movement called "The Lighthouse Movement," which is meant to encourage believers to prayerfully transform their homes into Neighborhood House of Prayer Lighthouse to reach our neighbors for Christ. The Lighthouse Movement is not a program or a project, but a prayer movement that is already at the heart of our church! A Movement meant to help believers learn effective ways to pray for and love or serve their neighbors. One resource we will use to learn how to transform our home into a Lighthouse for their neighborhood (or live the Shema), is the book The Art of Neighboring: Building Genuine Relationships.

This thought-provoking book presents a simple, but profound question: What is the most loving thing you can do for the people who live on your street or in your apartment building? The book encourages believers to look beyond their front doors and create meaningful connections with their neighbors by having meaningful conversations, sharing meals, and attend community events together. However, in our current culture, we have increasingly become more isolated and have had less connections with those living nearby.

The book shares true stories of lives impacted by intentional neighboring and provides practical guidance on how to build authentic friendships with those who live around us. Good neighboring doesn't require grand plans, but small, consistent acts of kindness and presence. Being a good neighbor has inherent value, even if your neighbor never becomes a Christian (think of the distinction between ultimate motives and ulterior motives, it's about embodying love and compassion, regardless of the outcome).

So, whether you're in the heart of your neighborhood or in the quiet countryside, "The Art of Neighboring" encourages us to rediscover the lost art of connecting with those who live around us with simple actions. Basic steps to help us break the ice and build connections - like learning and using the names of our neighbors.

People often feel they need to do more or be more — smarter, funnier, or wealthier—to make a difference. However, everyone has unique strengths and qualities that can positively impact their neighborhood. We need to remember that building relationships takes time and consistent effort through regular, small interactions, like greeting neighbors when you see them or inviting them over for coffee or a root beer. It is only fear and time constraints that stop us. So please watch for more small, but practical ways to live the Biblical Shema.

Also, mark your calendar, November 3 at the Community Church, and November 4 at the Union Grove Church, for our Annual Ministry Fair where we will celebrate our previous year of ministry, look to goals and strategies of our upcoming year of adventure and ministry.
