Grace and peace to you from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ; grace that provides divine assistance for daily living and peace to comfort us through all circumstances of life! Every month I enjoy using that same introduction Paul the Apostle used as he started many of his letters to Christians. In fact, he used this blessing to encourage believers, and I want you to receive and experience this blessing as well. And the Good News is that you can experience the fullness of God's blessings of Grace and Peace, as well as the Christmas blessings of hope, joy, and love!

Imagine that stary night, many years ago, when something extraordinary and supernatural was in the air. In the City of David, the Messiah was found, all warmly wrapped up and lying in a feeding trough. The Promised One, the Messiah, God had finally come to be with His people; but God came in the most unexpected way! God did not come as a conquering general riding in on a white steed as their culture was accustomed to. Our conquering God came into the world as a little human baby, a baby who cried and needed to be cared for! But not as an ordinary baby... but a baby who was fully human and fully God. There is actually a term to describe this God/man, it is the Hypostatic Union – fully God and fully human.

That is why one of Jesus' name's is "Immanuel," which means "God with us." In fact, that is why another part of the Good News is that the Lord has not left us alone in this world! God has called each of us to come into a relationship with Him, to be redeemed by our Savior's precious blood, to immediately be transformed and forgiven – to be given a second birth as explained in the bible and described in the second stanza of the classic Christmas Carol "Hark! The Herald Angels Sing."

But living this new life doesn't just happen. We need to learn how to live this new life, it is a lifelong process! That is why God came into the world – to save us, to help us and to fulfill us! Then, God sent His Holy Spirit to empower and enable those who trust Jesus to live this new life. Why? Because it is impossible to live the Christian life without Him, no matter how hard we try on our own. We need God, and we are given the choice as to whether we welcome or hinder the Lord's empowering and transforming hand. Yes, admitting we cannot do it on our own, is a very humbling choice.

If the Christmas season heightens your expectations of satisfaction, please join us at the Community and the Union Grove Churches of the Community Regional Shared Ministry this Christmas Season as we hear how to live the life you were created for! A life supernaturally filled with the hope, peace, joy, and love promised by the Savior whose birth we celebrate. 


The Men's Breakfast is canceled for this month. With so many events falling on the same day, we decided to cancel and wait until January. Next Men's Breakfast is


