Pastor's Letter

Grace and peace to you from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ; grace that provides divine assistance for daily living and peace to comfort us through all circumstances of life through the power of the Holy Spirit! The Community Church has a long history of being an Evangelical Church and tapping into God's power and peace to live life of faith! The church was founded after the 1870 Awakening came to the community of Waterford, and revival returned in the 1970s when God called Rev. Peter Garcia to the Community Church in the beginning of the Jesus movement (a Christian Awakening that began on the West Coast of the US in the late 1960s and moved across the globe before subsiding in the later 1980s). In 1984 God called Rev. Clarence Cheever to the Community Church. During this time, God transformed countless lives, raised up several evangelists, and called countless people into various ministries.

The Community Church has truly been a lighthouse for the Lord. That accounts for the picture of the lighthouse by the door entering into the office! Think of the image of a lighthouse! It stands on the rocks, with its light flashing, highlighting the route of safe passage to any ship making its way through a channel that's filled with many hazards and reefs. When you think of water, in the Bible it is also the image of life, so one can imagine boats filled with people navigating life's challenges. The light is Jesus Christ, who is "the light of the world." Who is the lighthouse? **It could be you; God is calling you to pray, care and share the light, Jesus Christ into your neighborhood!**

That is the vision of the Lighthouse Movement, an interdenominational Christian coalition that is prayerfully seeking to mobilize local churches to establish neighborhood lighthouses -- with a goal of reaching 260 million Americans. This movement (not a program and not a project) is to help believers, families and groups, to walk their neighborhoods, learn names and start praying for those living around you, in the five households that live around you in every direction.

Imagine how it would feel to have someone you may not know, praying to God for you! Praying for your family, your community, even praying for your relationship with God! That has been in the DNA of the Community Church for generations. Now, in the Lighthouse movement, the Community Church's vision is for you and me to bring God into our neighborhoods on a personal level to combat crime, resolve differences, strengthen families and more! My prayer is that God will use this movement to bring another Spiritual Awakening to the Waterford area and beyond! And the Leadership of the Community Church and the Community Regional Shared Ministry is extending this invitation to you, our members and friends of the Community Regional Shared Ministry!

Becoming a lighthouse does require a prayer commitment -- the promise to pray for, care for and share the gospel for a designated list of neighbors, and the friends of acquaintances of those living around you. This information is available through a website and app that is available through the Lighthouse Movement! All with the emphasis on reaching those who do not know Christ.

The prayer can be done in creative ways, ranging from simple prayer - to making use of an on-line journal and App to track the prayers and how they are answered. Prayer walks are another way for individuals, couples or groups to walk through neighborhoods, quietly praying for people by name as they walk past their homes.

But Lighthouse movement is more than prayer, it's also about caring for the people on the prayer list by performing acts of kindness, building relationships and socializing. For me, I took down a large tree in my back yard, and have been offering firewood to my neighbors, building friendships, and when the Lord provides an opportunity, I will share my faith.

One resource that will be available and taught soon will be the book, "The Lighthouse Movement." This book is a complete 'tool kit' on how Christians can become lighthouses to their neighbors and reach them with the gospel. Helping us to focus on being a Light and carrying the message of hope through - praying, caring, sharing. **Watch for more information! Have a great summer!**


Vacation Bible School 2024—He Knows Ewe, John
