Pastor's Letter

Grace and peace to you from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ; grace that provides divine assistance for daily living and peace to comfort us through all circumstances of life through the power of the Holy Spirit! Do you remember the parable of the Good Samaritan? In that timeless parable, Jesus taught us the Biblical Principle that everyone is our neighbor, and we should care for them. But we are surrounded by so many people, how do we live out that Biblical principle in practical ways? If we see *everyone* around us as our neighbor, it would be near impossible to take effective steps to interact with or care for people as Jesus did.

In the July and August Pastor Letter, I introduced you to a simple but extraordinary way to live out that Biblical Principle. It is a prayer movement called "The Lighthouse Movement." The vision of the Lighthouse Movement is to prayerfully encourage believers to transform their home into a Neighborhood House of Prayer or a Lighthouse to reach our neighbors for Christ.

The Lighthouse Movement is not a program nor a project, but a prayer movement that is already at the heart of our church! Part of The Lighthouse Movement is to help believers, families or groups learn effective ways to pray for their neighborhoods. Then, depending on your personality and how the Lord leads you, you pray for or walk your neighborhoods as you pray. Then learn the names of those who live around you through an app that is available, to personalize your prayers for your neighbors.

Part of The Lighthouse Movement is to consider the people who live immediately around you. Do you know them? Do you know anything meaningful about them? Are you showing anything that resembles genuine love to them? Before we go on, I know some of you are already starting to feel a little uncomfortable or awkward, you are not an extrovert, or your neighbors are very private or even neighborly. But it's what Jesus modeled, and Holy Spirit will move in incredible ways that will build a thriving community of believers!

Here are some principles to remember as you consider participating in the Lighthouse Movement:

- While God calls us to care for our neighbor as well as being present and supportive, we must also recognize our own limits and understand healthy boundaries. God is not calling us to take on more than what we are responsible for or to take on more than we can handle.
- There is a concept called "Reciprocal Hospitality." The idea is to not only offer help, but also being willing to receive help from our neighbors. This mutual exchange of care fosters deeper connections, it breaks down barriers, and it creates a more authentic and balanced relationship. I know, this is an area that does not come easily to me either. But it is a powerfully true ministry principle!
- Also, there is another concept called, "unhurried time." Here we want to have genuine interactions with our neighbors, so that requires us to slow down and even make changes so we can love our neighbors even better. This is another area that is a struggle for most people, especially while you are raising kids. But I can't find an escape clause for not loving our neighbors just because we're really busy.
- Finally, it is very important for us to remember this very important principle and here it is we are not responsible for the outcome of our neighboring. We are called to love as Jesus teaches, no matter of how we are received. If we focus on outcomes of our effort, we miss the essence of Jesus' teaching on how to live in relation to those around us.

Loving our neighbors well is an aspiration that we need more of as we pray for our neighbors and hope to turn our cities into true communities. By being a Lighthouse in our neighborhood, we can create a place where genuine connections grow into stronger, more compassionate Christ centered communities.





- 1.) Individual designated giving to the general mission fund
- 2.) The church gives 4% of its budget to missions to pay our partners. This year has seen a challenge in individual giving and is at risk of lowering our contribution to these amazing partners. We are currently running at 58% for the first six month of 2024 over last years figures. We pray that God will guide our congregation over this matter and continue to bless our missions ministry.

This month we have two different opportunities to serve in our community.


Opportunity 1: Assist at St. Vincent DePaul Waterford store. Various tasks.


