
Discussion Questions

Ephesians 3:1-11 The Great Mystery Revealed - Jesus Came for ALL



1. Read Ephesians 3:1-11

Describe what the Great Mystery is. It has 3 parts.

Why would this be so significant to the Ephesian Believers?

2. Re-read Ephesians 3:7-10

Why do you think Paul emphasizes that he is the least of the least?

What is the role of the church in verse 10?

How does fellowship in Christ among diverse people groups reveal the great wisdom of God, and proclaim His great power?

- 3. James shared in verse 6, that Paul creates a new word, sússōmos, combing the Greek words of Body & Together to say that Jesus makes the two groups one new "together body." What implications does this have for us today?
- 4. Discuss who the "gentiles"/outsiders are in and around your life today? What is at least one step that could be taken towards sharing the unsearchable riches of Christ with one of them this week?



Ephesians 3:1-11

For this reason I, Paul, the prisoner of Christ Jesus for the sake of you Gentiles — Surely you have heard about the administration of God's grace that was given to me for you, that is, the mystery made known to me by revelation, as I have already written briefly. In reading this, then, you will be able to understand my insight into the mystery of Christ, which was not made known to people in other generations as it has now been revealed by the Spirit to God's holy apostles and prophets.

This mystery is that through the gospel the Gentiles are heirs together with Israel, members together of one body, and sharers together in the promise in Christ Jesus. I became a servant of this gospel by the gift of God's grace given me through the working of his power. Although I am less than the least of all the Lord's people, this grace was given me: to preach to the Gentiles the boundless riches of Christ, and to make plain to everyone the administration of this mystery, which for ages past was kept hidden in God, who created all things. His intent was that now, through the church, the manifold [multi-faceted] wisdom of God should be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly realms, according to his eternal purpose that he accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord

Ephesians 3:6 NIV

This mystery is that through the gospel the Gentiles are heirs together with Israel, members together of one body, and sharers together in the promise in Christ Jesus.

Ephesians 3:6 The Message
