

EGG-O-Rama!!!

IMPORTANT THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- This event is designed to be an entry point for families in our community to see First NLR and experience the love of Jesus. No matter what job you have, you are making a lasting impact in the lives of families in our community.
- **All volunteers should park at Central Baptist Church** (at the corner of Somers and Fairway - in the lot across the street from their building). There will be a shuttle to bring you to the church. If you need to return to your car, go to the shuttle stop under the front awning in Lot A1 and a shuttle will take you. **Shuttles will run from 7:30am to 2pm.**
- When you arrive please proceed directly to the **Main Awning** to sign in and receive your nametag and instructions. **Everyone must sign in and get a nametag before going to your assigned location.**
- **All volunteers need to be at their assigned location NO LATER than 30 minutes before your shift begins (9:30am). We recommend an hour before the event to park, sign in, and get to your location on time. Volunteers for Saturday setup can arrive at the designated time given.**
- **Feel free to wear any First NLR apparel you have!** Just be sure to dress comfortably for the weather and the work you'll be doing!
- If you work in **Parking Services** please sign in at **Volunteer Central** as well. There you will receive all the information you need plus your radio.
- **We will have water at the event, but there will be no food.**
- **Childcare will NOT be provided during Egg-O-Rama.**

Everything is Better in Teams!

Preschool Birth-2 Years Old Egg Hunt – Team Leader: Emilie Loy

Place 120 plastic eggs per hunt at various places in plain sight around the egg hunt area. Allow 8 kids at a time inside the egg hunt area. Allow parents/family to come inside to take pictures and escort their child as needed. Have one worker standing at the exit to “supplement” any child’s basket that doesn’t have many eggs, and to give each child one bag of Fruit Snacks and one bag of M&Ms as they leave.

Preschool 3-5 Years Old Egg Hunt – Team Leader: Emilie Loy

Place 388 plastic eggs per hunt at various places in plain sight around the egg hunt area. Allow 20 kids at a time inside the egg hunt area. Have them line up around the perimeter of the hunt. Encourage parents/family to stay outside the fenced in hunt area to take pictures. If the parent insists being inside to escort child, allow them. When you say, “Go,” they may begin to run and pick up eggs. No pushing, shoving, or stealing. Whoever’s hand touches the egg first is the winner of the egg. Have one worker standing at the exit to “supplement” any child’s basket that doesn’t have many eggs, and to give each child one bag of Fruit Snacks and one bag of M&Ms as they leave.

Preschool Egg Hunt Entrance – Team Leader: Cherith Dollar

Welcome families into the lobby and direct them to the proper egg hunt based on their child’s age.

Special Needs Egg Hunt – Team Leader: Bailey Guinn

Place 200 plastic eggs per hunt at various places in plain sight around the egg hunt area. Allow 12-15 kids at a time inside the egg hunt area. Have them line around the perimeter of the hunt. Because of the nature of this egg hunt parents/family are encouraged to help their children as much as needed. They can assist their children or take pictures. When you say, “Go,” they may begin to run and pick up eggs. No pushing, shoving, or stealing. Whoever’s hand touches the egg first is the winner of the egg. Have one worker standing at the exit to “supplement” any child’s basket that doesn’t have many eggs, and to give each child one bag of Fruit Snacks and one bag of M&Ms as they leave.

Elementary K-5th Grade Egg Hunt – Team Leader: Katie Espejo

Place 400 plastic eggs per hunt at various places around the egg hunt area. Allow kids to hunt eggs and play in the MAC Party Zone area. No pushing, shoving, or stealing. Whoever’s hand touches the egg first is the winner of the egg. Have one worker standing at the exit to give one bag of M/Ms and one bag of Skittles to each kid.

Elementary Egg Hunt Sign Holder – Team Leader: Pastor Nick Kohler

Hold a sign at the beginning of Lot A3 that directs people to the elementary egg hunts. The sign has an arrow that directs them around the back of the MAC building. Be friendly and help direct people the right way.

Stroller Valet for Elementary Egg Hunts – Team Leader: Mike & Michelle Stafford

Volunteers will assist families with strollers as they enter the elementary egg hunt. Strollers will be tagged and brought to the pick-up area. When families exit the egg hunt, volunteers will retrieve the family's tag and match it to the corresponding stroller.

Bunny Photos Line Leader: Pastor Reta Russell

You will assist families to and from their bunny photo room.

Bunny Photos Line Runners – Team Leader: Pastor Reta Russell

Assist families to and from the bunny photo rooms. You will be located in MAC class room hallway.

Bunny Photos Room Assistant – Team Leader: Aaron Stone

Assist Bunny Photos Photographer and help families in and out of the room! Pass out slips of paper letting guests know where to get their photos online. You will be located in MAC rooms 7-10.

Bunny Photos Photographer – Team Leader: Aaron Stone

Take guests' picture with the Easter Bunny! You will be located across the portal in the Power Outlet area.

Bunny Photos Character – Team Leader: Aaron Stone

Sit on the bench and pose with children for their photo. You will be located in either room 7, 8, 9, or 10 of the MAC.

Bunny Photos Entrance – Team Leader: Melody Jones

Help direct traffic in and out of the building for bunny photos.

Bunny Photos Sign Holder – Team Leader: Melody Jones

Hold signs directing people to the entrance of the bunny photos area. Be happy and vocal.

Face Painting Line – Team Leader: Miranda Stone

Greet and assist kids/families in line and direct them to the face paint artists, as well as, helping them exit when finished. Keep the line moving as quickly as possible, but also, more importantly, make sure everyone is having a fun and exciting experience. You will be located next to the MAC building.

Face Painting Artist – Team Leader: Mackenzie Peirce

Paint on each child's face with a design according to the options given to you by the team leaders. You will be located next to the MAC building.

Water Tents – Team Leaders: Bryan Valadez

Offer water to guests passing by. You should have two coolers of iced down water bottles. Smile and be friendly.

Elementary Obstacle Course (1) – Team Leader: Pastor Nick Kohler

One worker stands at entrance instructing children 5th Grade and under (direct pre-school aged

kids to the Preschool Lane) to remove their shoes and place to the right of the entrance in an orderly fashion. One worker should be at end of the obstacle course assisting children in exiting. Kids can pick up their shoes at the front of the course. *Parents can walk beside kids if needed.

Elementary Obstacle Course (2) – Team Leader: Pastor Nick Kohler

One worker stands at entrance instructing children 5th Grade and under (direct pre-school aged kids to the Preschool Lane) to remove their shoes and place to the right of the entrance in an orderly fashion. One worker should be at end of the obstacle course assisting children in exiting. Kids can pick up their shoes at the front of the course. *Parents can walk beside kids if needed.

Egg-O-Rama Raceway – Team Leader: Pastor Nick Kohler

- Starting Line Attendant #1
 - Usher player(s) to the starting line and get them in position. As players are getting set to race, engage with them to hype them up for the race. Once the racers are ready, yell, "On your mark, get set, <blow whistle>".
- Starting Line Attendant #2
 - Usher player(s) to the starting line and get them in position. As players are getting set to race, engage with them to hype them up for the race. Once the racers are ready, yell, "On your mark, get set, <blow whistle>".
- Finish Line Attendant #1
 - When the whistle blows, click the start button on your stopwatch to begin tracking the time for the player in your lane. When the player in your lane crosses the finish line, click the button on your stopwatch again to record their final time. Announce your player's time to see who won. If your player has the fastest time of the day, record their time on the "scoreboard".
- Finish Line Attendant #2
 - When the whistle blows, click the start button on your stopwatch to begin tracking the time for the player in your lane. When the player in your lane crosses the finish line, click the button on your stopwatch again to record their final time. Announce your player's time to see who won. If your player has the fastest time of the day, record their time on the "scoreboard".

Elementary Chalk Area – Team Leader: Pastor Nick Kohler

We will have a large area where kids can draw with chalk. Please monitor and make sure they are not drawing or writing anything inappropriate. Let them have fun for a few minutes and switch them out based on the length of the line.

Parking Services / Shuttles – Team Leader: Pastor Layne Mason

Sign in at Volunteer Central under the main awning. You will receive instructions and your radio. Volunteers will direct parking and run shuttles.

Prize Registration Team – Team Leader: Larry Daniel

Have guests tap with their phone. Doing so registers them for a \$500 Visa gift card. If they are having trouble with the taps, they can scan the QR on the back of the tap. Please be available to answer questions they may have about the church and invite them to services this weekend.

Saturday Setup – Team Leader: Pastor Gary Tomlinson & Pastor Sophia Walthall

Sign in at the MAIN ENTRANCE at 8am and then report to Pastor Gary and Pastor Sophia at the Kids Ministry Check-in Awning for an assignment. Assignments will be given upon arrival. Some of the duties include transporting items, blowing up balloons, decorating, etc. We will work until everything is ready for the event. *Park at Central Baptist Church when you arrive. A shuttle will*

bring you to the volunteer check in.

Welcome Team – Team Leaders: Sharon Hall

You will be stationed at the entrance of the event and greet people as they get off the shuttle. You have one of the most important jobs because you will make one of the first impressions people receive. Be friendly, smile, and help answer any questions guests may have.

Finishers (Tear Down)

Sign in at the MAIN AWNING no later than 11:30am and then report to your Finishers Team Leader (below) at your assigned location (below) to receive your first assignment. If you are already serving at the event, then check with your Team Leader as soon as your area shuts down. Follow instructions given by your team leader to place all items in their proper place. Stick around until we're finished and the campus is ready for our first Easter service of the weekend that Saturday night at 5pm!
