3 OF THE MANY THINGS HAPPENING AT BETHEL

- 1. Our June summer outdoor worship service was a great success and we are looking forward to the **outdoor service on Sunday, July 13th!** Join us for a blended service, traditional and Gate of Life, in our Courtyard. Bring a chair or blanket to sit on. In the case of inclement weather, the service will be held in the Sanctuary.
- 2. At the Bethel Church Council meeting on June 17th, the decision was made to implement a three-month trial period of keeping the exterior doors of the Bethel church building locked continuously except for worship services (including funerals and weddings), concerts, and special events as determined by the Bethel staff. The trial period will be from July-September and a time for evaluation in late September will determine next steps. As with any change, things may not always go smoothly, and we ask for grace in these three months. Ideally, you will be able to access the building easily for events you attend with our front door intercom system. Our hope is that Bethel continues to be a welcoming place. If you have any questions, please direct them to the Bethel Church Council or to staff members Nick Marquardt or Janet Hoffmann who serve as staff leadership on the Safety and Security Team that meets monthly at Bethel.
