

FAITH Statement

Mentors & Youth: The following questions are guidelines as you discuss your faith and life together. Soon each student will have to write a faith statement that is submitted to the pastors of Bethel in preparation for being confirmed. Discussing these questions now will prepare you for that eventual assignment. You do not have to answer all of the questions in your Faith Statement, but certainly can.

1. Describe what your Faith in God is like right now. Be honest! Is it strong or important or confusing? Describe what you mean.
2. Think about the life, death and resurrection of Jesus. How does this affect your life? What does He mean to you?
3. What events (happy or sad) in your life has really shaped your faith or trust in God? Describe how they affected you.
4. Are there people in your life who have helped you in your Christian walk? How have they helped?
5. Think about your experiences in Church (confirmation, youth activities, Sunday School, etc.). What are some things you will remember for a long time. Why?
6. What things are you most thankful for in your life? Why?
7. What do you find difficult or challenging about being a Christian? Describe.
8. Is PRAYER important to you? How has it helped you?
9. Find a Bible verse or passage that you like. WHY is it important to you?
10. How do you plan to live out your Faith in the future? Honestly, what will your involvement in the Church be? What gifts and talents can you offer the Church?
