Dear Crossroads Family,

As we reflect on the past year, we are filled with gratitude for all that God has done in and through our church. While numbers can never fully capture the stories behind them, they do provide a glimpse into the life-changing work of God's Spirit among us.

This year, **more than 60 people** made decisions to follow Christ at Easter, and **over 60 individuals** took the important step of baptism. **More than 500 families** committed to the two-year FORWARD One Fund Initiative, demonstrating their faith and investment in the future of our church. We also welcomed nearly **500 children** to Kids Camp, made possible by the faithful service of more than **200 volunteers**. Plus, our Young Adults ministry saw almost **100 people** at their summer kickoff. This is the best turnout to date.

Each of these numbers represents a person, a family, a story, and a reminder that God is moving in powerful ways. Lives are being changed, faith is growing, and together we are making an impact for His Kingdom.

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS

We are pleased to report that work on the parking lot expansion is moving forward.

The first phase—combining our two existing lots into one property—is currently underway. We expect the remapping process to be finished within the next five months.

At the same time, we are advancing the design and

approval process for the new parking lot. Surveying and utility work are nearly complete, and we are in the process of selecting a professional design consultant.

Because the project requires Town of Parker approvals, including public hearings, the process takes time. At this point, we hope construction will begin in the first quarter of 2027.

DEBT REDUCTION

Your generosity through the FORWARD One Fund Initiative is already making a tangible impact. One of our primary goals was to reduce church debt, and because of your faithful commitments and giving, the Crossroads Leadership Council approved an additional \$75,000 each month toward paying down our debt. This is more than double what we have been paying each month.

These extra monthly loan payments will reduce the Crossroads projected debt balance by half by March 2028 and should save \$200,000 of interest expense over the life of the loans. This progress is a testament to what God can do through a church united in faith, generosity, and vision for the future.

MISSIONS / OUTREACH GIVING

We have started giving our financial support to these mission projects:

- **Sufficient Bread (Romania)** and their church building project
- **True Impact (Uganda)** and the construction of a kitchen and dining facility at Salem Christian School

- **Youth for Christ (Lebanon)** and their mentoring program for refugees displaced by the conflict in southern Lebanon

Your generosity will continue to impact lives and share the love of Christ both locally and around the world.

PROGRESS TOWARD OUR GOAL

During this initiative we are seeking to fund growth in missions and outreach, expand our campus capacity, reduce debt and prepare for future ministries. All giving currently goes to the FORWARD initiative which includes our ministry expenses as well as our FORWARD initiative priorities.
