What to Wear and NOT Wear - *Keep it classy.*

Be comfortable, remembering that you will be on the move, AND you will be making an impression on our young friends. By the way, we've asked the kids to adhere to these standards too, so don't let them show you up!

We suggest:

- Dress **modestly** and **comfortably!**
- Athletic or closed toe shoes are best for our activity level. **No flip-flops or sandals.**
- Shorts are fine, but **no short shorts!** Modest means mid to low thigh or longer.
- No spaghetti strap, low neck or midriff shirts.
- Sunscreen is a must. You will be outside for a portion of each day.
