While our program is free, we ask that each family bring the following items to add to the success of the week:

On Monday, June 9, Please bring...

Each Family:

- Last name begins with A-G, 1.5 lbs of seedless grapes (per family)
- Last name begins with H-M, a 6 pack of individual bags of Pirate's Booty snacks (per family)
- Last name begins with N-Z, a 6 pack of individual bags of Goldfish snack crackers (per family)

For Our Service Project, Each Child Should Bring:

- 1 Jump Rope **OR** 1 deck of kid friendly playing cards **AND** 1 Can of Meat (particularly chicken) **OR** jars of nut butters **OR** legumes (dry or canned)

We will have clearly marked drop off locations for these items

Safety...

Please notify our Admin Team in the West Lobby if...

- There is an allergy change
- Early pick-up is needed
- Someone different will be picking up your child

Snacks...

- **Only the requested snack contributions of grapes, Goldfish Crackers and Pirates Booty will be accepted.**
- We have an alternative for those kids who cannot eat snacks with gluten or dairy.
- To protect as best as we can, for the diverse allergy and dietary concerns, we will not allow your child to bring their own snacks, unless previously approved.

What to Wear and NOT Wear

- **Be sure** to generously **apply sunscreen** before arriving each day. Staff & volunteers are prohibited from doing so.
- Comfortable clothing and **athletic footwear** for daily rec activities are a must.
- **NO** really **short shorts**, revealing clothing, flip flop sandals or spaghetti straps. **Keep it classy, please!**

What to Bring and NOT Bring

- **A WATER BOTTLE DAILY, 16 oz or less, marked with child's first/last name** (we have a refill station)
- Your family's contribution to snack, service and craft projects outlined on the the reverse page.
- EpiPen if required
- **NO** cell phones or electronics.

Parents **MUST** accompany their child in and out of the church and to and from their Group each day!

Check-In and Check-Out Process

- Please use the WEST LOBBY entrance doors for drop-off and pick-up.
 - Check-In is from 8:45 – 9:00 a.m. at the iPad kiosks in the West Lobby – Program starts promptly at 9:00 a.m.
 - Pick-up is at 12:00 p.m.. This is a **FREE** program, and we are grateful for our volunteers. Please help us honor their time by **promptly retrieving** your child!
- Place your child's nametag sticker on the front of their shirt **AND** take your claim ticket number. ***The claim ticket MUST be presented at pick up. Be sure you have your ID in case you lose the ticket! **TIP: Take a photo of your claim ticket** in case you misplace it or someone else is picking up your child. **Note:** Ticket codes change daily!
- Escort your child to their group leader/row in the Main Auditorium, DAILY. Their color group and number will be noted on their name tag. We'll be there to help should you need it.
- At pick-up, follow the signs to the retrieval line. We'll be allowing a controlled number of parents into the Auditorium about every 60 seconds. We ask that you be patient and kindly follow the plan so every child will be safe, our volunteers will not be overwhelmed, and your exit experience is as quick and seamless as possible. ****TIP: Be sure you have your claim ticket ready!****
- Please **be mindful** that retrieving your child early can be very disruptive for everyone. We're happy to bring your child to you in the West Lobby, if it's absolutely necessary they leave the program early. Come to the West Lobby or North Business doors if you need to enter the building earlier than 11:50 a.m..
