Faith That Goes With You

Go in peace, and may the God of all grace go with you. adapted from 1 Peter 5:10

Faith at home isn't just what happens inside your house. It's what leaves with you when you go. It's the quiet courage that shows up at work. The kindness that carries into the store. The peace that steadies you during hard conversations.
