

A Place to Belong

You shall love your neighbor as yourself. Mark 12:31

When Jesus was asked to name the most important commandment, he didn't hesitate. Love God with everything you are. Love your neighbor as yourself. The two belong together, like breath and life.

This kind of love isn't passive. It creates space where people can show up honestly, be received fully, and discover they are not alone. A true welcome is more than a friendly smile at the door. It's the kind of love that says, "You are safe here. You can learn here. You belong here."

In a world where so many are told they don't measure up, Christ's church is called to be a different kind of space; not perfect, but open, courageous, and healing. When we practice this welcome, we don't just extend hospitality. We participate in God's own work of love that transforms lives.

This Week's Practice: Make Space for Wonder

- Welcome someone new into your routine: at work, at school, or in your neighborhood.
- Create one safe space for honest conversation and listening.
- Encourage another person by naming the gifts you see in them.
