

Sunday Morning Study - August Revelation.....for Beginners?? led by Roger Baker

In August we're going to do a study on the Book of Revelations. This is going to be a "hi level" overview looking at God's timeline through the end of the age. We'll be using a book titled "What Happens Next" by Max Lucado. This study is not an attempt to "explain" in detail all the prophesies and what they mean or how they will actually unfold. We could spend a month of Sundays trying to do that and still probably be confused. Rather this study will just attempt to identify the key events identified in the scriptures and the sequence in which they will occur. Lucado's book is a down to earth discussion of maybe the most complicated book in the Bible, easy to read. And leaves the ultimate interpretation of these events up the reader. To give you a sense of Lucado's approach and maybe style, here is the last paragraph in the introduction:

"One final word. I have a reserved a seat at the PWPOET Cafe in heaven - Pastors Who Preached On End Times. We will celebrate what we understood correctly, chuckle at what we missed entirely. Mostly we will HONOR the one TEACHER who stands above us all, Jesus Christ.


