The Ministry of **Paying Attention**

Where Every Voice Belongs



In worship, music is never just a filler, it is formation. Every note, every silence, every invitation to sing is a decision about who belongs, who leads, and who gets to feel seen.

Music ministry is a holy calling. It is also a form of iustice:

- It invites those who don't preach to proclaim.
 It gives the child, the elder, the off-key voice, and
- the soloist a place in the song.

 It honors tradition and opens the door to the unfamiliar.

To our church's musicians: your ministry matters more than you know. Every time you rehearse, show up early, sing through pain, or play when you're tired, you are creating space where others can meet God.

And to the Church as a whole: What we sing, and how we sing it, tells the world who we think God is and who we believe is welcome. Pay attention to that.

This Week's Practice: Let the Music Lead Us Deeper

- Thank someone in music ministry this week, especially someone who works behind the scenes.
- Reflect on how music has helped you feel seen or
- connected to God this year.
 Ask: How can we continue to reflect the fullness of God's people and story through our music?
 This isn't about fixing anything. It's about growing

together with joy and intention.

Before You Go...

Music doesn't have to be perfect to be powerful. Whether you're in the choir or the pew, your voice matters. And what we create when we sing together? That's something holy. This week, keep your ears open. Let a lyric linger. And if someone's song lifts you up - tell them.
