When Courage Becomes Faithfulness

But the midwives feared God; they did not do as the king of Egypt commanded them, but let the boys live.

Exodus 1:17

The story of Shiphrah and Puah begins in the machinery of empire; a system built on fear, control, and violence. These two women were given an order to participate in death. Instead, they chose life.

They didn't have armies, titles, or political power. What they had was moral clarity: the quiet, stubborn conviction that God's command to protect life mattered more than Pharaoh's command to end it. Their defiance was not loud or public, but it was faithful, and it changed the course of history.

The Church still stands in that lineage of holy defiance. Every time we choose compassion over convenience, truth over silence, justice over comfort, we stand with them. Their courage echoes in the voices that feed the hungry, welcome the stranger, challenge injustice, and create communities where dignity is protected.

We are stewards of that same courage. To give, to serve, to stand up - these are not small acts. They are the ways we resist apathy and despair. They are how we make God's love visible in a world that too easily forgets it.

This Week's Practice: Acts of Courage

- Speak a gentle truth where silence feels easier.
- Support someone who's taking a risk for justice or kindness
- Pray each morning: God, give me the courage to choose life today.
