Faith at the Table

Give us this day our daily bread. - Matthew 6:11

The table is one of the most ordinary places in your home, and one of the holiest.

Jesus did so much ministry at tables:

- He ate with tax collectors and sinners.
- He blessed bread with his friends.
- He used meals to heal, shame, restore dignity, and show what the kingdom of God looked like.

At the table, people were seen. At the table, no one was invisible.

In a world of fast food, busy schedules, and screens everywhere, we often forget that sharing a meal is a spiritual act. It's not just about the food; it's about the presence.

And for the Church, paying attention at the table means asking: Who has a place here? Who doesn't? What kind of world are we creating with our hospitality?

This Week's Practice: Make the Table Sacred

- Pick one meal this week, and slow it down. Sit, bless the food, and eat with intention.
- Invite someone to join you who might not often be invited, or imagine what it would look like to do so.
- As you eat, name where you saw God that day.

Before You Go...

The table isn't just where we feed our bodies, it's where we remember who we are. So set it with love. Serve with joy. And know that when you pay attention, even lunch can become liturgy.
