### **Praise the Lord!**

I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith.
2 Timothy 4:7

There's a particular kind of grace that comes with finishing something well. Not just crossing the finish line, but looking back with honesty, releasing what's been done with peace, and making room for what's next.

It's a sacred pause before the next story begins.


A good finish is not an ending. It's a benediction.
