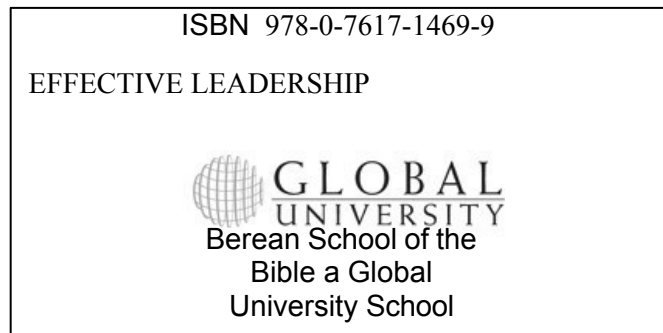

Course Plan and description

MIN251 Effective Leadership (5 CEUs)

This course is a biblical approach to the principles of leadership that applies those principles in the church setting, giving the student the practical skills needed to serve in leadership in the local church.

In addition to using your Bible, we recommend that you also use *Developing the Leaders Around You* by John Maxwell to enhance your learning experience.



Course Objectives

Upon completion of this course, you should be able to

1. Identify biblical examples of leadership and explain lessons that can be learned from these lead
2. Explain the characteristics of a leader's heart and how they are cultivated.
3. Explain the requirements of the godly leader for guiding the church of Jesus Christ.
4. Identify the various tests of leadership and what they seek to develop in a leader's life.
5. Explain the mission of the church as provided in God's Word.
6. Explain the process of vision from its inception to its communication to the body.
7. Describe the recommendations of Moses' father-in-law and how they apply to modern leadership
8. Explain the five levels of leadership and how we can progress to the highest levels.
