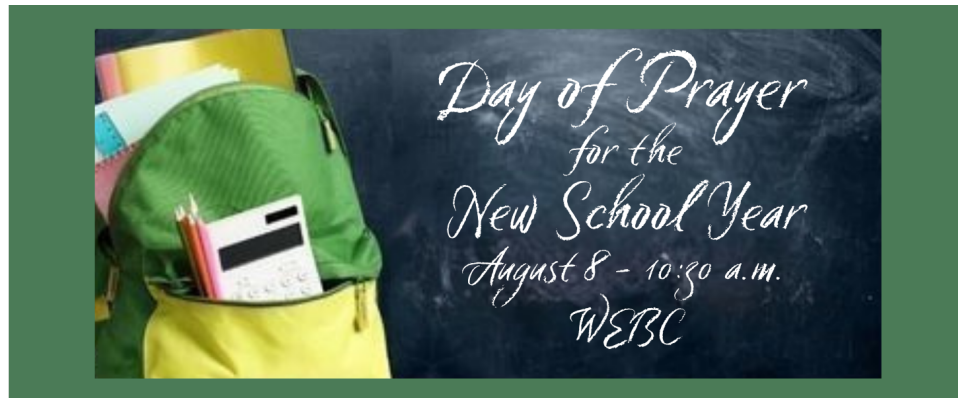
Father, enable our teachers to:
