For the Filipino children:

Father God, we thank you for the children who will attend the children's ministry while our mission team is in Masinloc. We ask that you give them ears to hear, and hearts that are receptive to the message of Jesus Christ. Help the mission team to bring love and compassion to these children, their families, and their communities. Help the team to love each child as you love them.

Matthew 18:1-5 - At that time the disciples came to Jesus, saying, "Who is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven?" ² And calling to him a child, he put him in the midst of them ³ and said, "Truly, I say to you, unless you turn and become like children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. ⁴ Whoever humbles himself like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven. ⁵ "Whoever receives one such child in my name receives me, ⁶ but whoever causes one of these little ones who believe in me to sin, it would be better for him to have a great millstone fastened around his neck and to be drowned in the depth of the sea.

Matthew 19:13-15 - Then children were brought to him that he might lay his hands on them and pray. The disciples rebuked the people, ¹⁴ but Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me and do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of heaven." ¹⁵ And he laid his hands on them and went away.

Specifically for the new church at Bunga-

Lord, this new congregation is preparing for their official beginning in their new building. Give provision and labor to complete the final construction, and prepare Pastor Aries to shepherd this new grouping of believers. Allow their visitations and Bible studies to be fruitful in planting your Word into the hearts of those in the community.

As when Paul spoke boldly in the name of the Lord in Jerusalem, and the church throughout all Judea and Galilee and Samaria had peace and was being built up (**Acts 9:31-32**), we pray that this new congregation will be built up and walk in the fear of the Lord. In the comfort of the Holy Spirit, multiply them for your glory.
