4. Read Isaiah 9:6–7 and Jeremiah 23:5–6 together. When Peter said Jesus was the Messiah, what expectations would that word have carried for a Jewish person in the first century?
5. How did Jesus fulfill the role of Messiah differently than people expected?
6. If Jesus really is the Messiah and King, what areas of life are hardest for people to surrender to His authority?
7. What experiences, people, or moments helped you become convinced about who Jesus is?

8. How should believing Jesus is the Messiah actually change how you live, make decisions, or treat people this week?
