What's a **small act of generosity** someone has shown you that you still remember?

Questions

1. When you hear the word **“generosity,”** who is someone (in your life or someone you've heard about) that comes to mind? What made their generosity stand out to you?
2. Read 2 Corinthians 9:7 together. The widow was not forced to give, yet she chose to give anyway. How does the idea of **joyful giving** challenge or reshape the way many people think about generosity?
3. Jesus teaches about storing treasures in heaven in Matthew 6:19–20. What are some examples of things people invest money, time, or energy in that **don't last eternally**, and what might it look like to invest in things that **do**?
4. What do you think changes in a person's heart when they begin to view generosity as an **eternal investment**?
5. In 2 Samuel 24:24, David says he will not offer something to God that costs him nothing. What do you think **sacrificial giving** looks like in everyday life today?
6. Many people feel like they spend everything they earn. What are some practical ways someone might **create margin in their life** so they have room to be generous?
7. The sermon ends with the idea: **“It's not the amount in your hand, it's the surrender in your heart.”** What does surrender in giving actually look like in a person's life, and how can someone tell if their heart is truly surrendered to God in this area?
