THE FIRST CHRISTMAS

AND

PURE EVIL

ore than 2,000 years ago a baby was born in Bethlehem. This baby was God in human flesh, the Word of God, the Son of God, the Light of the World, the Messiah of Israel, the most important person ever born into this world. And when He was born the devil tried to kill Him.

Now, you might say that it was Herod who tried to kill the baby Messiah, Jesus. That is true, but do you know who was behind Herod? Who was making Herod do it? We learn the answer to those questions in Revelation 12:1-6.

And a great sign appeared in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars. She was pregnant and was crying out in birth pains and the agony of giving birth.

And another sign appeared in heaven: behold, a great red dragon, with seven heads and ten horns, and on his heads seven diadems. His tail swept down a third of the stars of heaven and cast them to the earth. And the dragon stood before the woman who



was about to give birth, so that when she bore her child he might devour it.

She gave birth to a male child, one who is to rule all the nations with a rod of iron, but her child was caught up to God and to his throne, and the woman fled into the wilderness, where she has a place prepared by God, in which she is to be nourished for 1,260 days.

The book of Revelation begins with the Greek word apocalypsis, from which we get our modern word "apocalyptic." But the word in Greek does not mean end times. It literally means "hidden things revealed." This is what the book is doing, revealing hidden things. Revelation is showing the world for what it truly is and showing us what is really going on, what has happened, and what will happen.

Revelation 12 is an epic visionary presentation of the battle that has been raging for 6,000 years. We cannot see it with our eyes. This vision reveals the spiritual realities. Here in Revelation 12, we see Israel depicted as a glorified, heavenly Eve, ready to bring forth the Messiah, the seed of the woman.


And the devil, depicted as a great red dragon, wants to eat that child as soon as He is born. Think about it. This was Satan's first opportunity to kill God and He tried to do just that. This reality is worked out in the evil, demonized, King Herod in Jerusalem pretending that he wants to worship the child with the Magi. He doesn't. God warned the Magi and then Joseph about Herod's duplicity. Herod was, in fact, Satan's agent in the world, trying to eliminate the Messiah before Jesus could do anything.

Then Herod, when he saw that he had been tricked by the wise men, became furious, and he sent and killed all the male children in Bethlehem and in all that region who were two years old or under, according to the time that he had ascertained from the wise men. Matthew 2:16

We see in all this a mighty contrast between evil and good, between the way of the world and the kingdom of Heaven, between the work of Satan and the work of God. Satan works in lies, brute force, and murder. God defeats Satan by the word of an angel, the birth of a baby, and the humble obedience of the baby's parents. It always looks like God is about to lose, but Satan never wins.

Satan uses people just like this, even today. People in this world will seek to advance what they think is their will using the weapons of this world; deception, slander, manipulation, intimidation, and murder. They might not know it, but they are serving Satan. Those who love the Lord do battle with the Word of God, prayer, faith in Jesus, and obedience to God even when we don't know what will happen. God is in control. He will win our victory.

Christmas is a celebration of a great divine victory. And how did God win? A baby was born into this world, amid all the hatred, scheming, deception, and murder. Mary had her baby Jesus, and the world has never been the same. Hallelujah!


