The International Day of Prayer and Awareness Against Human Trafficking

is celebrated annually on **Feb. 8**, the feast day of St. Josephine Bakhita, a survivor of enslavement and patron saint of the Sudan and Human Trafficking. St. Josephine was a Catholic Religious Sister who joined the Canossian Order after winning her freedom from slavery. She was canonized in 2000. St. Josephine was known to have served with gentleness and warmth and was responsible among other things to welcome visitors to the Convent. On her feast day Catholics worldwide are encouraged to attend Mass to create a greater awareness about human trafficking. When you attend Mass on this day, please whisper a prayer for those who are victims of human trafficking.
