WEEK 1  God is the one true King. What does this mean for me?	WONDER & DISCUSS  READ TOGETHER: Daniel 7:14.  Who is part of God's kingdom?	Take turns pretending you are "king" of the house. How are you going to rule your "kingdom"?	PSALM 24:10 Who is the King this verse is talking about?	Make a list of specific ways to trust God to be the King of your family this week.	Play "This or That." Discuss any surprising answers.  READ TOGETHER: 1 Samuel 16  DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
WEEK 2 God sees our hearts. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: Proverbs 21:2 What does it mean to "weigh the heart"?	Make paper hearts together. Leave them around your home to remind each other that God sees your heart.	PSALM 24:10 How can we give glory to God?	Share what you notice about each other's hearts.	Go on a walk together. Worship God for His creation.  **READ TOGETHER: 2 Samuel 6:16–23 **DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
WEEK 3 God is worthy of worship. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: Psalm 150 What can we praise God for?	Create a collage with images that remind you of worshiping God.	PSALM 24:10 Why is God worthy of our worship?	Spend time worshiping God together through music.	Plan and create a family feast "fit for a king." <b>READ TOGETHER:</b> 2 Samuel 7 <b>DISCUSS:</b> What does this teach us about God?"
WEEK 4	READ TOGETHER: Isaiah 40:28  How do you feel knowing that God will never grow weary?	Create a "Family Covenant." Consider basing it on Scripture. Display it in your home.	PSALM 24:10 Will God's kingdom ever end?	Make a cross with two craft sticks. Write the words "Forever" and "King" across the sticks. Decorate together.	Discuss the best advice you've ever received and why it was so great.  **READ TOGETHER: 1 Kings 3:3-15; 4:29-34  **DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
