Questions for Younger Kids

1. The angel said, “Do not be afraid.” What are you sometimes afraid of, and how can remembering that Jesus is alive help you feel calmer?
2. If Jesus is stronger than death, what does that tell you about how big and powerful He is?

Questions for Teens

1. The sermon said Easter brings peace with God, peace within, and peace about tomorrow. Which of those three do you feel you need most right now, and why?
2. The Bible says the same power that raised Jesus from the dead is available to us. What’s one area of your life where you need God’s power instead of trying to handle it on your own?

Simple Family Application for This Week

Choose one “fear” or worry as a family (it could be about school, money, health, friendships, the future).

- Write it on a piece of paper.

- Together say: "Because Jesus is risen, we don't have to be afraid of this."

- Pray over it, then put the paper in a box, a jar, or somewhere visible as a reminder to trust Jesus with it this week.

Each day, when someone feels worried, pause and say, "Jesus is alive, and He's ahead of us," and ask Him for peace and power.
